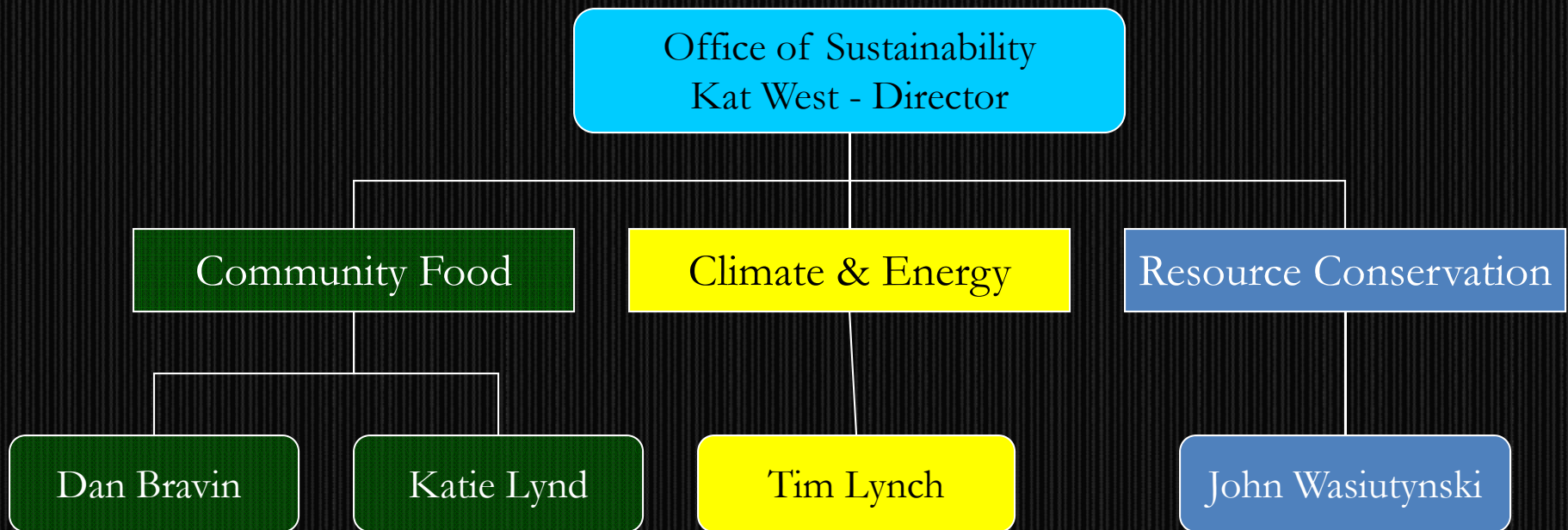

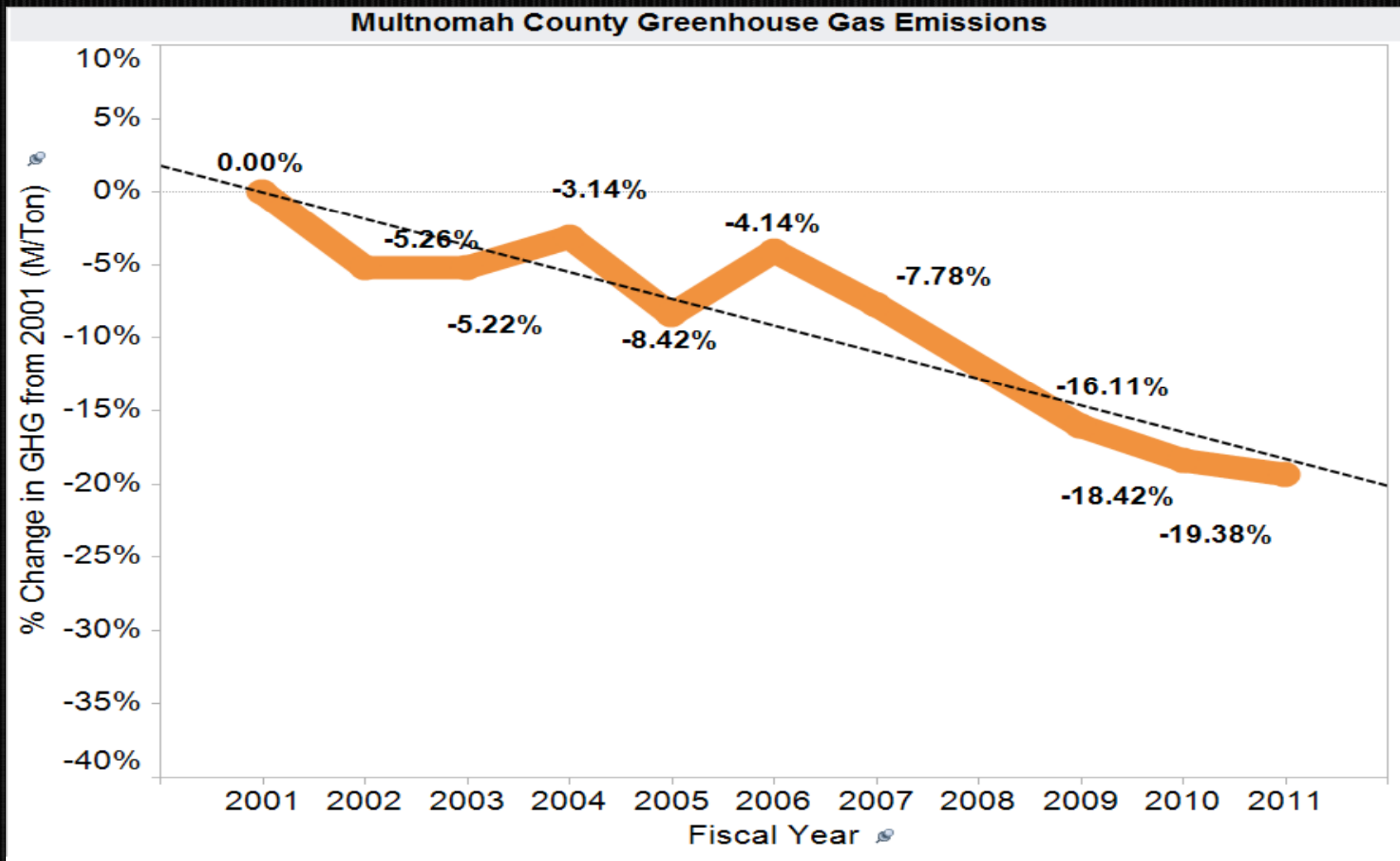

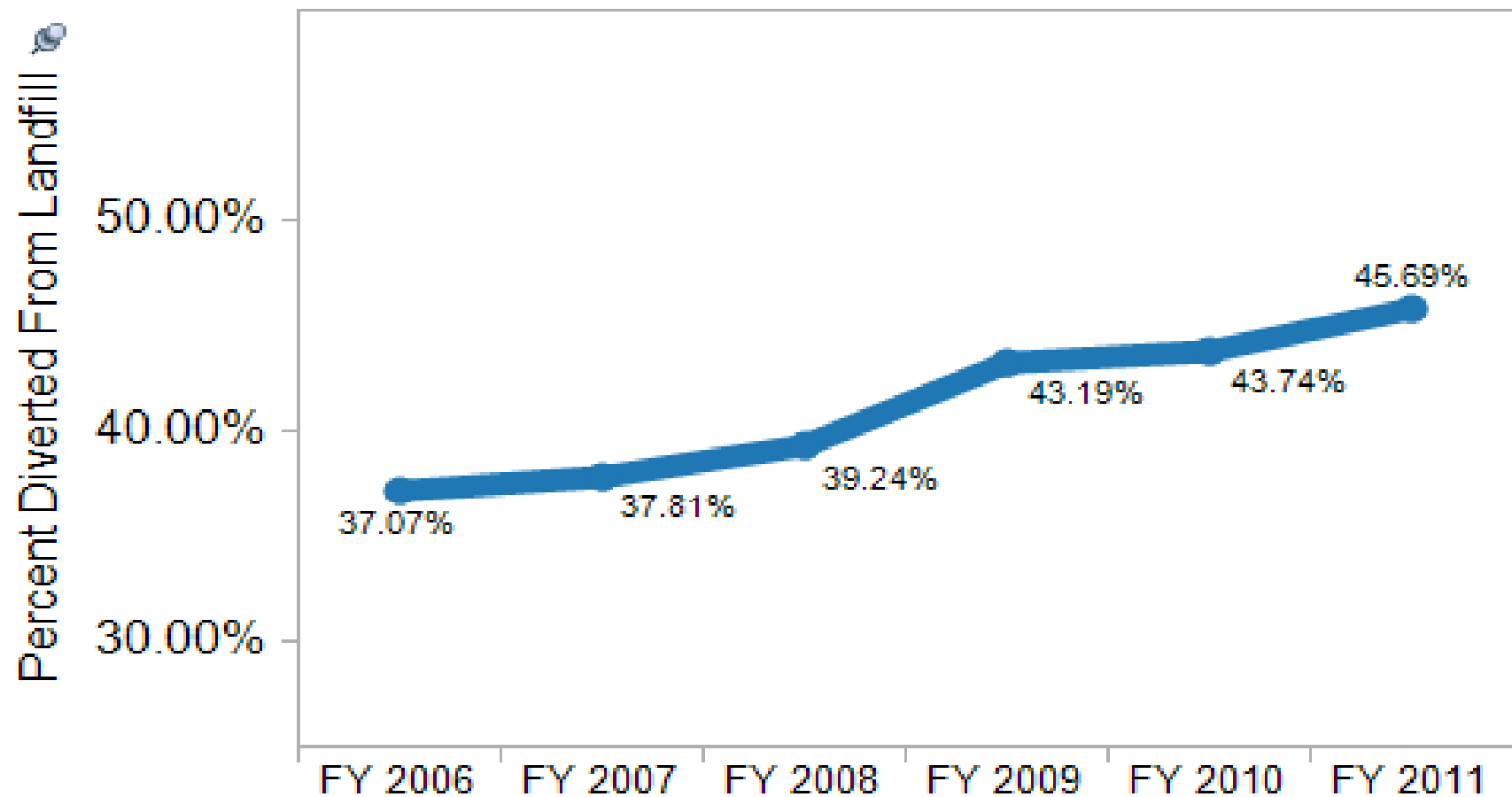
FY11 = over \$1 million cost savings

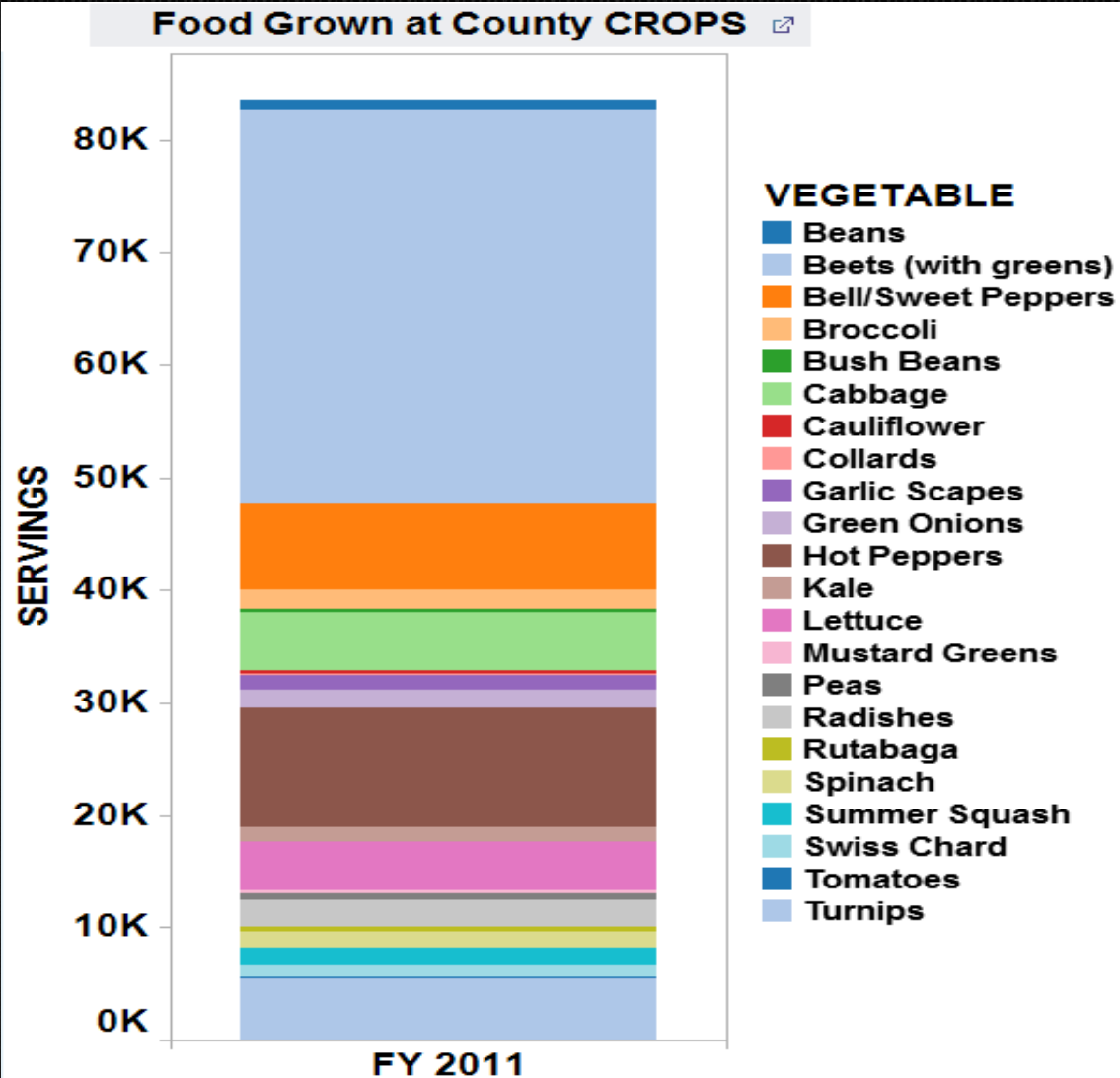


BUFA – Restitution Garden - MCE



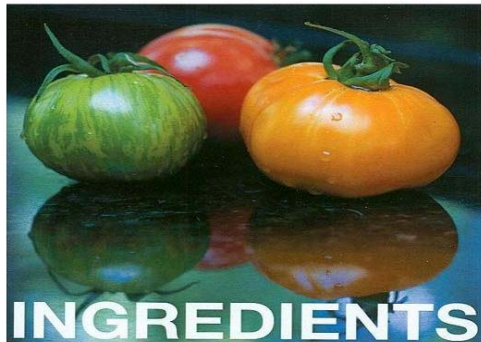
