RESOLUTION NO. 07-019

Authorizing the repurchase of a Tax Foreclosed Property by the Former Owner, ETOILE T. JOHNSON

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Multnomah County acquired the real property described below through the foreclosure of liens for delinquent property taxes, and ETOILE T. JOHNSON is the former owner of record.
- b. ETOILE T. JOHNSON has applied to the County to repurchase the property for \$15,446.53 which amount is not less than that required by ORS 275.180; and it is in the best interest of the County that the property be sold to the former owner.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. The Chair is authorized to execute Bargain and Sale Deed D072120 conveying to the former owner the following described real property:

LOT 8, BLOCK 1, SCOFFINS ADDITION
2. The County's Tax Title section is authorized to forward the signed deed to the appropriate Escrow Officer under letter of instruction which shall provide:
 - (a) That the deed is to be processed only upon the receipt by the County of all funds the County is due in consideration for the above described property, and all municipal charges have been paid in compliance with ORS 307.100; and
 - (b) That if the escrow is closed without the proper payment to the County the original deed and any copies shall be returned to the County.

ADOPTED this 18th day of January, 2007.


