

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON

Ordinance No. 338

An ordinance creating the Citizen Involvement Steering Committee.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1.

There is hereby established the Multnomah County Citizen Involvement Steering Committee. The Committee shall develop, monitor, and evaluate the County's Citizen Involvement program, and shall be functionally attached the first year to the Department of Intergovernmental Affairs.

Section 2.

The Committee shall consist of 25 people appointed by the County Executive with the approval of the Board of Commissioners. Members shall serve two year terms and be eligible for reappointment. Members may serve no more than two consecutive terms.

Section 3.

Members shall include 12 representatives of community planning groups in the unincorporated area of the County, 5 representatives of City of Portland neighborhood associations, 5 representatives of East County cities, and 3 members at large. The community groups, the neighborhood associations and the East County cities will be requested by the County Executive to submit recommendations for appointment from their organizations. Membership may expand to include representation from new community groups as they form.


Section 4.

The Committee shall elect its own Chairperson and meet at least once every two months.
