Approving a Change to the Funding Level of the Joint Office of Homeless Services.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

a. The Joint Office of Homeless Services Intergovernmental Agreement signed between the City of Portland and Multnomah County requires at Section 7.3 that any changes to either party's funding of the Joint Office be approved by the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners and Portland City Council.

b. The Joint Office of Homeless Services, formed to improve outcomes for people experiencing homelessness, is funded by and through the City of Portland and Multnomah County. The City wishes to transfer additional money to the County, which houses the Joint Office, to increase its funding level of the Joint Office. The parties believe that by transferring this funding to the Joint Office, the funds may be more efficiently spent and the related programs more efficiently administered.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

To approve a change to the funding level of the Joint Office of Homeless Services, as required by the Intergovernmental Agreement that created it, and to approve conforming or technical changes to a number of other provisions in the agreement.
