ORDINANCE NO. 70

An Ordinance amending Section 303 of Ordinance No. 62, the Multnomah County Building Code, to provide for a fire inspection fee for services to be performed by the Multnomah County Building Official which were previously performed by the Oregon State Fire Marshall.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 303 of Ordinance No. 62 is amended by adding subsection (c), which reads:

(c) Fire Inspection Fees. When a building permit has been issued and the Building Official has performed duties under the authority granted by the provisions of ORS 476.030, 479.215, 279.217, 479.220 and 480.450, a fire inspection fee equal to one-half the plan-checking fee as required by subsection (b) of this Section shall be paid to the Building Official.

Section 2. Adoption. This ordinance, being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the people of Multnomah County, shall take effect on the thirtieth day after its adoption, pursuant to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.

ADOPTED this 3rd day of May, 1973, being the date of its Second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
