The goal of the presentation is to provide an update on the implementation of HB 3194, a criminal justice bill passed in 2013 by the Oregon legislature. HB 3194 reduces prison sentences for certain crimes, expands presumptive probation, allows for early release for inmates to participate in re-entry programs, and creates a justice reinvestment grant program for counties to assist with efforts to reduce recidivism. In order to guide the program, HB 3194 established a Task Force on Public Safety. The Multnomah County Local Public Safety Coordinating Council (LPSCC) appointed a Steering Committee of local public safety partners to make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners on the best use of funds. The presentation will outline the main aspects of the Multnomah County Justice Reinvestment Program (MCJRP) created by this Steering Committee, summarize the impacts of HB 3194 and this program, and include outcomes and related data of the current program participants.
