Approval for County Attorney to join as *Amici* before the United States Supreme Court in the *State of Arizona v. United States of America* litigation.

The County of Santa Clara, California asked Multnomah County to join a United States Supreme Court "Friend of the Court" or *Amici* Brief filed on behalf of local governments throughout the Country opposing the Arizona Senate Bill on immigration. The Arizona Bill requires local law enforcement to make investigate immigration status, detain all arrestees until their immigration status is verified, and take other actions with respect to unauthorized aliens.
