The above entitled matter is before the Board of County Commissioners to consider execution of a Quitclaim Deed relinquishing interest of Multnomah County in certain parcels of real property, formerly portions of N.E. Lombard Street; and

It appearing to the Board that certain parcels of real property originally acquired for road purposes are no longer required, in as much as the road has now been vacated, and that the property has been incorporated into Portland International Airport; and

That those parcels may have accrued to Multnomah County through the process of street vacation; and

It is the recommendation of the Department of Environmental Services that a Quitclaim Deed be executed conveying any interest that may be vested in Multnomah County to the Port of Portland;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that Multnomah County quitclaim to the Port of Portland that certain real property described as follows:

A portion of Lots 17, 18 and 19, ACKLEY RIVER FARMS, a plat in Multnomah County, Oregon, recorded February 4, 1922, in Plat Book 870, Page 43, which is described as follows:

All that portion of Lots 17, 18 and 19, said ACKLEY RIVER FARMS, lying within the right-of-way of N.E. Lombard Street, former County Road No.'s 1124 and 3239, vacated by the city of Portland under Ordinance No. 152953, dated March 30, 1982, and Ordinance No. 153852, dated October 4, 1982.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners be hereby authorized and directed to execute a quitclaim deed relinquishing Multnomah County's interest in said property to the Port of Portland; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that said deed be duly recorded in the Deed Records of Multnomah County and returned to the Department of Environmental Services, Division of Transportation.



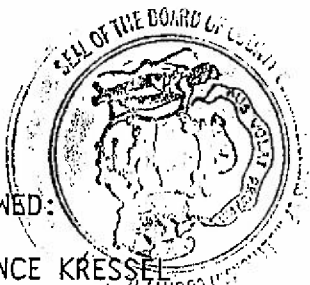
