

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
FOR THE COUNTY OF MULTNOMAH  
ORDINANCE NO. 505

An Ordinance providing for the establishment and operation of an Integrated Pest Management Advisory Committee.

WHEREAS it is in the public interest to provide a forum for discussion of the policies and actions regarding the operation of an integrated pest management program, and

WHEREAS it is important to improve the quality of vector control services to county residents by reviewing all aspects of the methods used to control vectors of public health significance and other pests,

Now THEREFORE, Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section I. Multnomah County hereby establishes the Multnomah County Integrated Pest Management (I.P.M.) Advisory Committee. The Committee shall consist of seven (7) members, to be appointed by the County Executive or Chair of the Board of County Commissioners with the approval of the Multnomah County Board of County Commissioners. The membership of the Committee shall be as follows:

1. Environmental Health Professional with Toxicology Background.
2. Representative from an Environmental Group
3. Vector Control/or Integrated Pest Management Specialist
4. County Extension Representative
5. Representative from Department of Environmental Quality
6. Pest Control Operator or a Representative of a Pest Control Operator's Trade Association.
7. One Representative At Large.

Section II. The term of each Committee member shall be three (3) years, commencing on July 1 of the year of appointment.

Section III. Board members shall receive no compensation for serving on the Committee.

Section IV. The Multnomah County Integrated Pest Management Advisory Committee shall perform the following functions, pursuant to ORS 411.155.

A. Assist in the information gathering and research necessary to develop an Integrated Pest Management Plan.

B. Evaluate the effectiveness of the Integrated Pest Management Plan.

C. Recommend changes in the Integrated Pest Management Plan.

D. Advise the Multnomah County Board of County Commissioners and the Department of Human Services on matters related to the Integrated Pest Management Plan.

ADOPTED this 20th day of March, 1986, upon passage of its second reading.
