14 Multnomah County ordains as follows:

16 Section I. Purpose
17

18 The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Multnomah County Code Sec.
19
20 2.30.112 . This amendment describes the expansion of the function of the
21
22 Aging Services Department. The expansion occurred when Disability Services
23
24 Offices were transferred from State to County administration under the Aging
25
26 Services Department , effective July 1, 1997. The name is changed to Aging
27
28 and Disability Services Department to reflect the addition of persons with
29
30 disabilities as a population served by the department.

32 Section II. Amendment of Multnomah County Code Sec. 2.30.112 .

34 Multnomah County Code Sec. 2.30.112 shall read as follows:
