ORDINANCE NO. 885

An ordinance to amend Multnomah County Code Sec. 2.30.112 ,  
expanding the function of the Aging Services Department to include services  
for persons with disabilities and changing the name to Aging and Disability  
Services Department.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section I. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Multnomah County Code Sec.  
2.30.112 . This amendment describes the expansion of the function of the  
Aging Services Department. The expansion occurred when Disability Services  
Offices were transferred from State to County administration under the Aging  
Services Department , effective July 1, 1997. The name is changed to Aging  
and Disability Services Department to reflect the addition of persons with  
disabilities as a population served by the department.

Section II. Amendment of Multnomah County Code Sec. 2.30.112 .

Multnomah County Code Sec. 2.30.112 shall read as follows:


(Language in brackets [ ] is to be deleted; underlined language is new)

[The department of aging services is established. ] The  
Aging and Disability Services Department is established. It shall  
provide social and health services relating to the needs of senior  
citizens and persons with disabilities in order to help them live as
