### General Information

#### 1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the resolution to levy property taxes for Fiscal Year 2014.

#### 2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

The resolution levies the taxes included in the FY 2014 Adopted Budget.

#### 3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

This action authorizes rate levies for the General Fund (Permanent Rate) of \$4.3434 per thousand dollars of assessed value and the Historical Society Levy of \$0.05 per thousand dollars of assessed value.

It also levies \$8,245,243 for bonded debt payments. Tax levies in support of bonded debt are excluded from the limitations imposed by Measure 5 and Measure 50.

#### 4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.

After the Approved Budget is submitted to the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission, no Fund may be increased by more than 10% in total revenue, and no property tax greater than the amounts included in the Approved Budget may be levied.

**5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.**

Three evening public hearings were held on May 8<sup>th</sup>, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, and May 29<sup>th</sup> to collect public input on the budget. Transmitting the Approved Budget to the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission allowed the public and Board further time to review the budget before final adoption.
