Multnomah county continues to face difficult budget decisions internally and with partners at the local, state and federal levels. Clear and compelling mission and vision statements are widely considered to be the mark of a healthy organization – the organizing force that drives effective adaptation, excellence, and success. An adopted mission, vision and values for the County will help provide the board framework to navigate difficult budget decisions and will provide pragmatic guidance for department directors. Critical functions enhanced by a centralized mission, vision and values statement include performance planning and appraisal, department- and division-level strategic planning, engaging employees with the “higher purpose” of the organization, and employee development activities.
