1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

The Board has requested an update on the MCSO policy change regarding acceptance of ICE I-247 detainees

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

On April 4, 2013, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution 2013-032, which supports the acceptance of ICE I-247 detainees only for persons charged with a felony or A person misdemeanor, or who pose a threat to public safety by meeting specific, documented criteria from ICE. On April 15, MCSO instituted a revised acceptance policy for ICE I-247 detainees, limiting the placing of ICE detainees to felony, A person misdemeanors, persons who pose a threat to public safety as documented by ICE and appropriate jurisdictional holds. This briefing will update the Board regarding the results of this policy change to date and issues surrounding development and future considerations of policy adjustments.

The policy discussion will focus on the Sheriff's Office policy for acceptance of I-247 detainees, how that policy changed in April and what has resulted from the change.
