General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board? Approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for improvements to NE Sandy Blvd from NE 230th Ave to NE 238th Drive.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results. NE Sandy Blvd is an important transportation link in East County and is vital to the economic vitality for the cities of Fairview and Wood Village. The section of Sandy is currently an unimproved 2 lane facility with limited bicycle, pedestrian and transit capability. This \$1,375,000 project will widen the existing road to allow for a center turn lane, improve drainage features and add bike lanes and sidewalks. The project will facilitate commercial growth at current vacant properties along Sandy Blvd. The project is strongly endorsed by our partner Cities of Fairview and Wood Village. Project design is already underway and construction is estimated for summer 2015.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing). The IGA authorizes grant funding at \$659,000. We have budgeted FY14 and FY15 County Road Funds for the difference in cost.

4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved. None

5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place. County staff has collaborated with the cities of Fairview and Wood Village and working with

adjacent property owners and business to minimize impacts and leverage other investments. Appropriate advance notice will be provided to the Public and the City staff. Additionally project updates will be provided to the community and the respective agency staff.
