ORDINANCE NO. 369

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 365 to extend the deadline for registration and payment of fees for existing signs and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Purpose

A. The purpose of this amendment is to extend the March 18, 1983 deadline for the registration of existing signs and the payment of registration fees.

B. Ackerley Communications, Inc. has sought preliminary injunctive relief from the fee provisions. The present deadline has pressured Ackerley Communications to seek an immediate preliminary injunction. This deadline extension is intended to relieve that pressure. It will not prejudice either side in the litigation.

Section 2. Amendment

Section .8637 (A), Ordinance No. 365 is amended to read as follows (new language is underlined; deleted language is bracketed):

- (A) On or before May 16, 1983, [Within 30 business days of the ordinance effective date,] the owner of an off-premise advertising sign structure previously established shall make application to register the sign with the Department of Environmental Services, on forms provided for the purpose.


Section 3. An emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect on the date that it is signed by the County Executive.

ADOPTION

This ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, shall take effect on March 11, 1983, according to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.

Adopted this 10th day of March, 1983, being the date of its first reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon


