1. What action are you requesting from the Board? Approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Sandy Drainage Improvement Company (SDIC) for maintenance and service to Multnomah County Drainage facilities within the SDIC service district.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results. Program offer 91013-15 Road Services. This IGA will formalize a long standing provision of services from the Sandy Drainage Improvement Company to Multnomah County Road Services. The service area is bounded by NE 223rd Ave to the West, NE Marine Drive to the North, the Sandy River on the east and within the Cities of Troutdale and Fairview. County Road Services has many drainage assets within this area and has relied on maintenance and service of those assets by the SDIC as an economical and efficient resource. SDIC is better equipped with staffing, tools and equipment for this type of work. Indirectly, by managing these assets for the County they are able to provide better service to the community for their primary mission, drainage and flood control.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing). This request is revenue neutral. County Transportation (via Road Fund) already budgets for and pays for these services on an annual basis.
