ORDINANCE NO. 117

An ordinance creating the Board of County Commissioners for Multnomah County as the local Contract Review Board for Multnomah County, pursuant to Oregon Laws 1975, Chapter 771, § 34(2), declaring an emergency and establishing an effective date.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners is hereby created as the local contract review board for Multnomah County. It shall have all the powers in the award of county contracts that the Public Contract Review Board shall exercise in the state at large, and in addition thereto, it may adopt rules and regulations relating to the award of county contracts which, where in conflict with the rules and regulations issued by the Attorney General, shall prevail.

Section 2. Emergency and Effective Date.

This ordinance being necessary for the implementation of the authority granted Multnomah County by Oregon Laws 1975, Chapter 771, § 34(2) on January 1, 1976, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1976.
