Proclaiming April 25, 2019 as Take Your Child to Work Day in Multnomah County, Oregon.

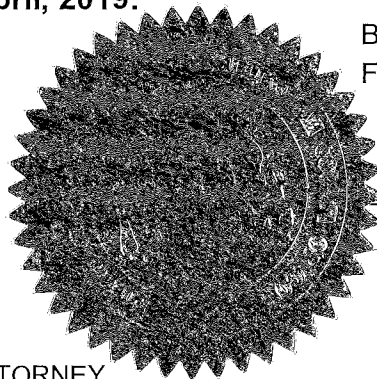
The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:
