ORDER
93-7

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on
December 9, 1992, the Budget Office indicated that the revenue
projected to be available in Fiscal Year 1993-1994 are likely to be
insufficient to meet current service levels of county programs; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on
December 9, 1992, the Budget Office indicated that the amount of
the anticipated shortfall in the budget for Fiscal Year 1993-1994
will be reduced by approximately \$2 million if there is no
inflationary increase provided for materials and services in the
constraints provided to each department and elected official for
budgeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners need to provide early
direction to the Budget Office to commence the preparation of the
Budget for Fiscal Year 1993-1994.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:


1. The constraints provided to each department and elected
official for budgeting for Fiscal Year 1993-1994 shall not include
