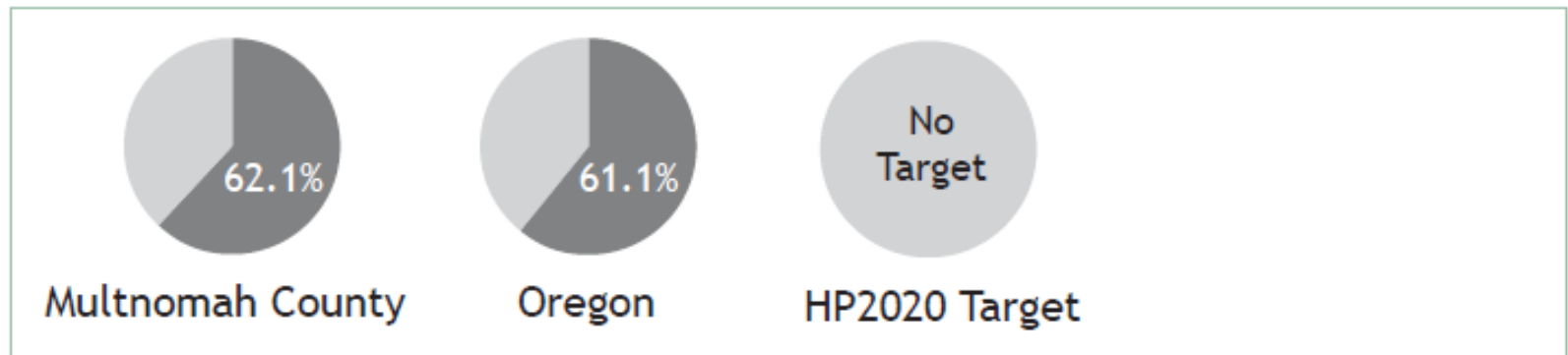

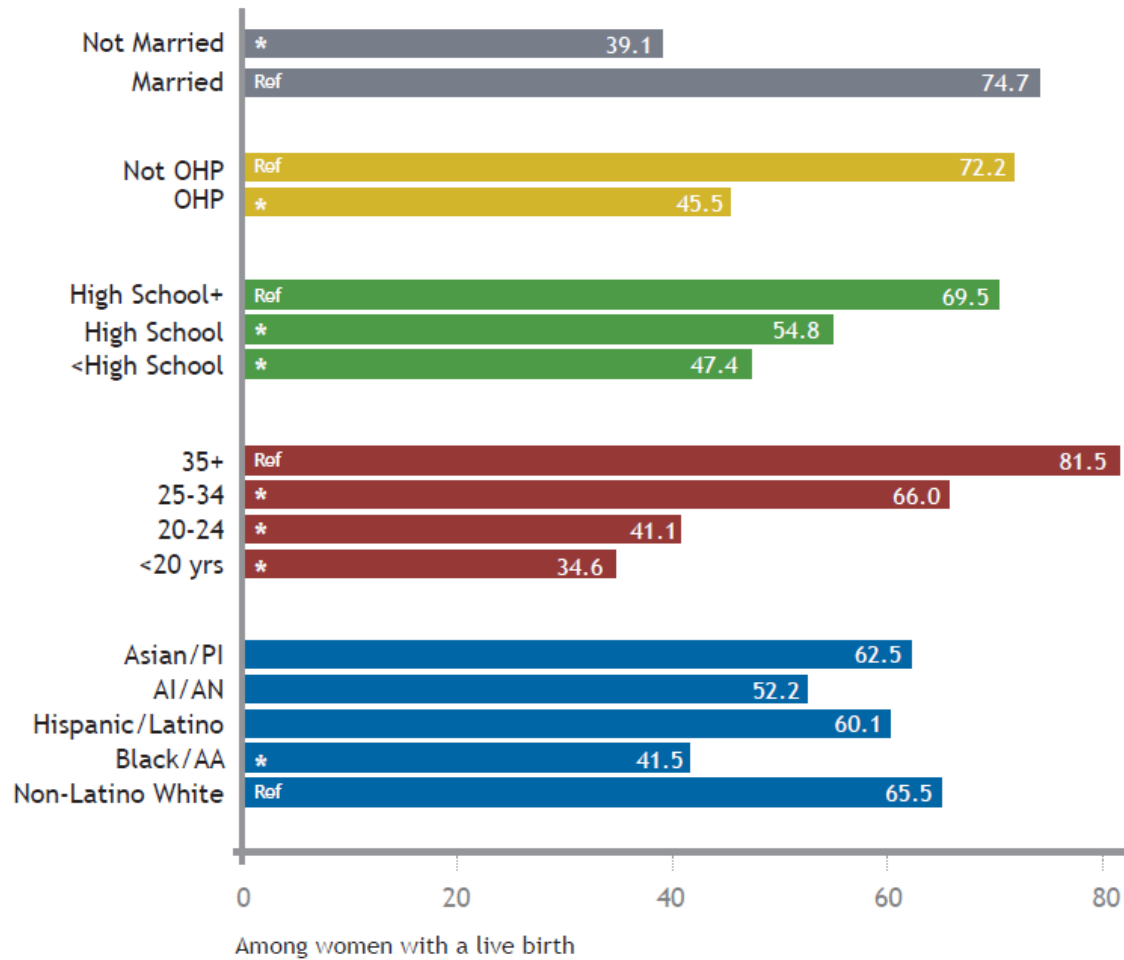
Pregnancy intention

Percent of recent mothers who reported that their pregnancy was intended, Multnomah County.

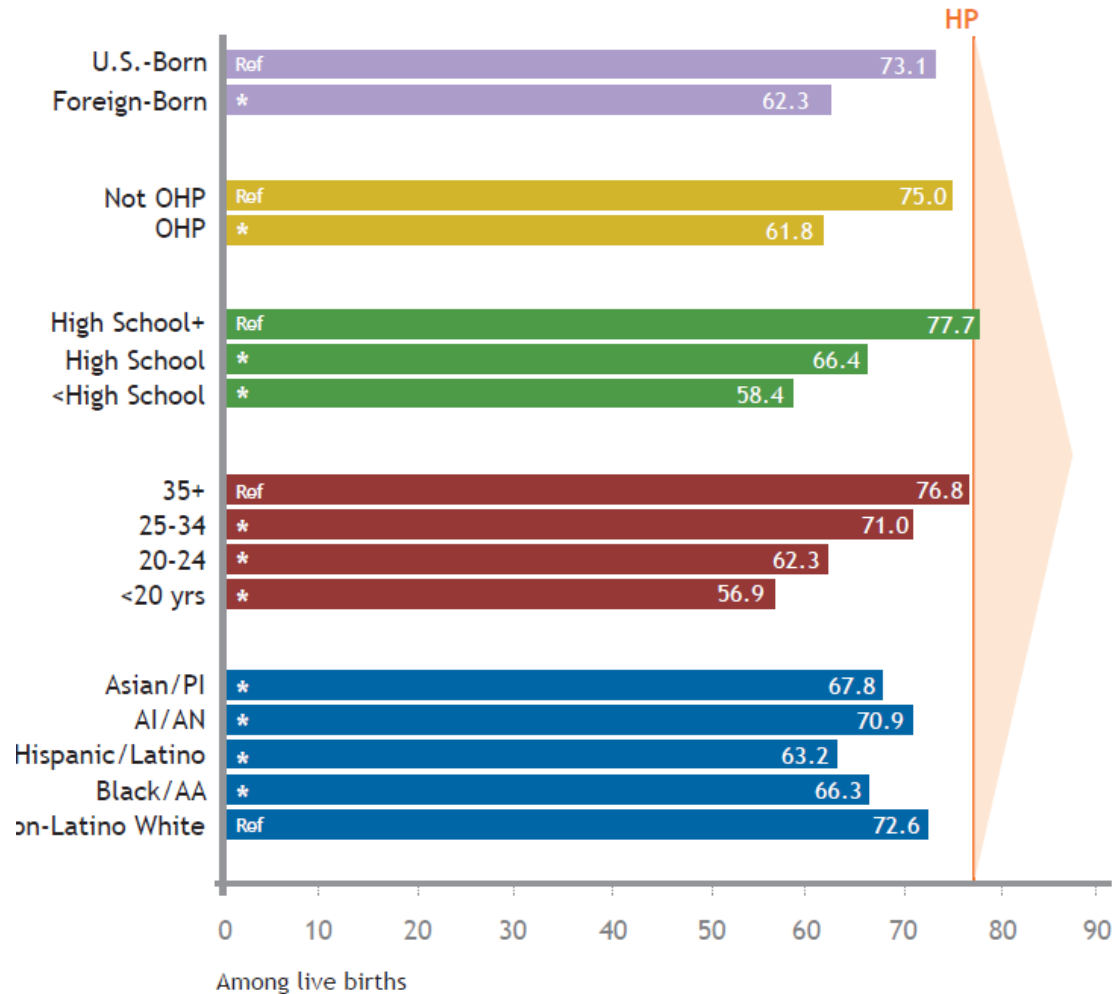

Pregnancy intention



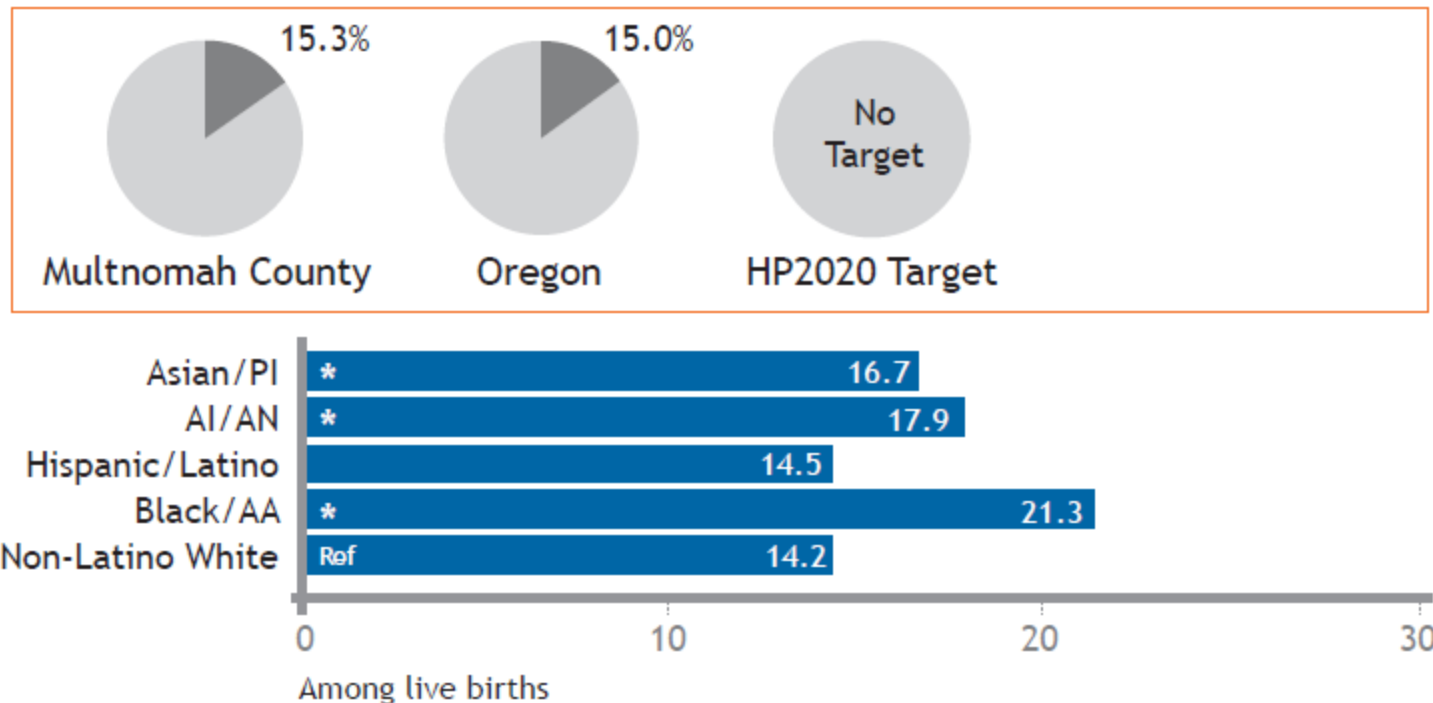
Access to prenatal care
