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Policy Recommendations

1. Institute a robust licensing program for the sale of tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems

- Require licensure for stores that sell tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems.
- Ensuring Education and training for owners and clerks about
- Enforce all state and local sales laws consistently, comprehensively, and fairly
- Licensing fees

2. Zoning Limits: Creating a Safe Space Around Schools

- Instituting new zoning limits would reduce access to youth without burdening already establishing businesses whose licenses would be grandfathered-in.
- Ensures that no new retailers, new owners, or new location seeking to sell tobacco products and inhalant are within 1000 feet of school.

Policy Recommendations

3. Minimum pricing and per pack tobacco quantities

- Ensuring pricing minimums to protect youth by preventing new smokers to try tobacco products.

4. Tobacco 21: Lowering Addiction Rates and Reducing Access to Minors

- Prohibit the sale of tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems to those of 21 years of age or older
