ORDINANCE NO. 458

An ordinance relating to the Department of General Services of Multnomah County. (Underlined language is added, bracketed language is deleted.)

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Multnomah County Code Section 2.30.450 is amended to read as follows:

2.30.450 Department of General Services. The Department of General Services is hereby established. It shall:

(A) Procure materials and supplies necessary for the operation of the County government.

(B) Operate and maintain County facilities.

(C) Manage and maintain County lands.

(D) Provide data processing services to the County government.

(E) Operate the County's accounting system and perform treasurer functions as required by state law; prepare necessary financial reports; and record the receipt, investment and expenditure of County funds.

(F) Regulate the county's cable franchising system.

(G) Operate the services of the budget officer as required by state law, prepare other necessary manuals and reports, evaluate County services and programs, evaluate existing and proposed grants, provide grant accounting services, monitor County contracts and assist departments in management analysis.

(H) Recommend a County program for collective bargaining, represent the board in collective bargaining and coordinate grievance proceedings as directed by the county executive.

(I) Provide employee related services as directed by the county executive and in accordance with board policy.

(J) Provide legal services to the board, county executive and departments as requested, provided however, the board by this authorization does not abrogate its authority to retain counsel in accordance with ORS 203.121

(K) Perform the duties prescribed by state law for the county clerks.

(L) Perform the duties prescribed by state law for the assessor and tax collector.

SECTION II. Multnomah County Code Section 2.30.800 is amended to read as follows:

2.30.800 Duties of [elected county officials] the sheriff.

[(A)] The sheriff shall perform the functions of that office prescribed by state law and shall administer the jails and corrections facilities of the County.

[(B) The county clerk shall perform the duties prescribed by state law for the county clerk as election officer.]

[(C) The assessor shall provide the services and perform the duties imposed by state law for the assessor and tax collector. The assessor shall also perform those duties prescribed by state law for the county clerk except those duties relating to election laws.]

SECTION III. Multnomah County Code Section 2.30.810 is amended to read as follows:

2.30.810 Compensation of elected officials.

(A) Compensation for elected county officials is fixed at:

- (1) Commissioner.....\$33,346
- (2) Executive.....\$43,180
- (3) Auditor.....\$33,346
- (4) Sheriff.....\$46,000

[(5) Assessor.....\$41,676]

[(6) District Court Clerk.....\$30,130]

[(7) County Clerk.....\$36,999]

(B) The county salary supplement for the district attorney is set in the amount of \$11,032.
