RESOLUTION NO. 2016-122

Authorizing the Repurchase of a Tax Foreclosed Property by the Former Owners, Brian & Margaret Vann.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Brian & Margaret Vann are the former owners of certain real property, more particularly described in the proposed deed to Brian & Margaret Vann, attached and identified as Exhibit A ("Property").
- b. On or about September 23, 2014, judgment was entered in Multnomah County Circuit Court foreclosing the delinquent taxes levied against the Property.
- c. On September 23, 2016, the County Tax Collector deeded all right, title and interest in the Property to Multnomah County as authorized under ORS 312.200.
- d. Brian & Margaret Vann have applied to the County in compliance with MCC Section 7.402 to repurchase the Property for \$34,788.32 which amount is consistent with ORS 275.180 and MCC Subsection 7.402(B).
- e. The County has received payment in the amount of \$34,788.32 from Brian & Margaret Vann, and it is in the best public interest that the Property be sold to the former owner.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. The County Chair is authorized to execute a deed, in substantial conformance with the attached deed, conveying the Property to Brian & Margaret Vann.
