ORDINANCE NO. 247

An Ordinance amending Section 5(B) of Ordinance No. 244 relating to cash payment to exempt employees for non-exempt accumulated unused sick leave.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 5(B) of Ordinance No. 244 adopted on July 24, 1980, is amended by deletion of Section 5(B) thereof and in its stead replacing the section with the following language:

"Section 5(B). Upon retirement or termination after vesting in the retirement system, an exempt employee shall be entitled to cash payment at his current hourly rate of pay for any sick leave accumulated during such time, if any, that the employee was not in the exempt status. Cash payment shall be paid according to the following schedule:

"a) Ten percent (10%) of the current hourly wage shall be paid for every hour accumulated up to 480 hours, except that no compensation shall be paid for accumulated sick leave to any employee who has less than 240 hours sick leave accumulated; and


"b) Twenty percent (20%) of the current hourly wage for each hour accumulated over 480 hours.

"c) Upon retirement or termination there shall be no cash payment for unused salary continuation entitlement."


Section 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, shall take effect on August 24, 1980, according to Section 5.50(2) of the Charter of Multnomah County.
