The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Congress and the President of the United States have designated the week of May 15 to 21, 2000 as PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL WEEK
- b. The County's Law Enforcement Deputies are dedicated to maintaining a safe and livable community for the citizens of Multnomah County
- c. The men and women of the Multnomah County Sheriff's Law Enforcement Division are responsible for the protection of life and property and the enforcement of the Oregon Criminal Code and County Ordinances and have a duty to serve all of the citizens of Multnomah County, the State of Oregon and the United States of America
- d. These dedicated public employees often place their own safety and well being in jeopardy. Some, through courageous deeds, have lost their lives or have become disabled in the performance of their duties
