

# Glossary of Terms

<b>EHR</b>	Electronic Health Record.
<b>Epic</b>	The physical health EHR product (and vendor) utilized by MCHD and provided by OCHIN. Stand alone Epic products are also utilized by 70% of the HSO partners including OHSU, Kaiser Permanente, Providence, and Legacy.
<b>Evolv-CS</b>	The mental health EHR utilized by DCHS and provided by Netsmart.
<b>FQHC</b>	Federally Qualified Health Clinic.
<b>HIE</b>	Health Information Exchange.
<b>HIO</b>	Health Insuring Organization.
<b>HIT</b>	Health Information Technology.
<b>HSO</b>	Health Share Oregon.
<b>Meaningful Use</b>	The set of standards defined by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and incentive programs that govern the use of electronic health records and allows eligible providers and hospitals to earn incentive payments by meeting specific criteria.
<b>Netsmart</b>	The vendor providing Evolv-CS, the system utilized by DCHS.
<b>OCHIN</b>	Oregon Health Information Network—systems integrator and claims processor providing HER services to partner federally qualified health clinics including Multnomah County, Clackamas County and Washington County, as well as many other local FQHCs.
