ORDINANCE NO. 40

An Ordinance providing for further requirements for continuing in County service beyond the age of sixty-five (65) years, and amending Article III, Section (2) (a) and (b) of Multnomah County Ordinance No. 12, as amended by Ordinance No. 27.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Article III, Section (2) (a) and (b), of Multnomah County Ordinance No. 12, as amended by Ordinance No. 27, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section (2) Compulsory Retirement; Compulsory Retirement Age; Continuation in Service; Eligibility; Withdrawal of Contribution.

(a) Any employee who has attained the age of 65 years shall be retired effective the first day of the month following his 65th birthday unless the employee shall request that he be continued in service and his continuation in service is approved by his appointing power and confirmed by the Board of County Commissioners.

(b) The request for continuation in service shall be made by the employee at least 60 days and not more than 75 days before his effective date of retirement in writing to his appointing power. If the request is approved, the employee shall be so notified in writing by the appointing power.
