WHEREAS Urban Renewal Programs use limited public dollars to stimulate private investments in local communities that, in turn, promote economic vitality and create new jobs.

WHEREAS An amendment to the state constitution will be required in order to give local voters the option of deciding whether or not they approve of paying for urban renewal bonds outside the property tax ceiling.

WHEREAS Multnomah County is a community which has benefited from Urban Renewal Programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners support Ballot Measure 1.
