WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Service District (METRO) has coordinated the development of a plan for a regional system of natural areas, open space, trails and greenways for wildlife and people entitled "Metropolitan Greenspaces Master Plan"; and

WHEREAS, the development of the Greenspaces Master Plan was a cooperative effort involving virtually every county and city in the region as well as a variety of state and federal agencies, non-profit organizations, businesses and concerned citizens; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County has supported the development of the Greenspaces Master Plan through significant contributions of financial aid and considerable staff time; and

WHEREAS, numerous opportunities were provided for public involvement and comment so as to assure the Greenspaces Master Plan would be comprehensive, scientifically sound and responsive to the desires of the regional community; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Service District formally adopted the Greenspaces Master Plan on July 23, 1992 and referred to the voters a measure authorizing implementation of the Plan and the sale of \$200 million in general obligation bonds to finance acquisition and development; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Greenspaces Master Plan is consistent with County policy as specified in the "Multnomah County Natural Area Protection and Management Plan"; and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds implementation of the Greenspaces Master Plan is important to the health, welfare and vitality of the region's residents, environment and economy; now therefore




