**ORDER**  
#88-90

The above entitled matter is before the Board of County Commissioners, acting in its capacity as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board, to consider a request from the Department of Environmental Services for an order exempting from the requirement of public bidding the purchase of Wild Model T 1600 Total Station Survey Equipment for an estimated \$28,492. DES has appropriated funds in the fiscal year 1987-88 budget.

It appearing to the Board that the recommendation for exemption, as it appears in the application, is based upon the fact that the original design computer for which this equipment must interface was competitively purchased by DES. Several local governments, including the Oregon Department of Transportation, are using Wild equipment, which allows for an exchange of information on common projects. Purchase of this equipment represents the most cost effective use of existing equipment and staff operation.

It appearing to the Board that this request for an exemption is in accord with the requirements of the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board Administrative Rules AR 10.100, 20.030 and 30.010; it is, therefore

**ORDERED** that the purchase of the Wild T 1600 Total Station Survey Equipment be exempted from the requirement of public bidding.
