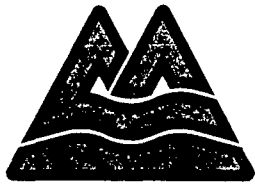

The Multnomah County Population Release Matrix System

In 1986, Multnomah County, Oregon, had 732 jail beds and nearly 1,000 inmates. State voters had turned down four prison bond measures since 1980, and county voters had twice rejected local jail and inmate rehabilitation levies. Like many jurisdictions, we had tried numerous population control measures with little long-term success.

The matrix system's goal is to maintain the custody population within the limits established by the court without increasing danger to the community.

To complicate matters, the federal court was looking over our shoulders because of a court order which addressed a jail that had been replaced in 1983 but continued to influence the "new generation" jail in downtown Portland.

From July 1986 through July 1987, we experimented with a release matrix system that depended on the approval and authority of the state

court judges. It became increasingly difficult to use this process, however, because of limitations placed by the local courts.

As a result of our continuing population problems, we returned to the federal court on an extension of the original order. On June 23, 1987, the federal court placed a population cap on two of our three facilities. Discussions with all parties to this action made it clear that without the authority of the federal court, the sheriff would have an extremely difficult time maintaining any capacity limit ordered by the court.

The matrix release program that we had been developing since 1986 was reviewed by the court

and ultimately included in the final court order. This gives the sheriff the authority to release inmates when the population reaches 90 percent of capacity.

Matrix System: Goals and Objectives

The goal of the matrix system is to maintain the custody population

within the limits established by the federal court without increasing danger to the community.

With this goal in mind, we identified a number of objectives to consider in developing the process. These objectives were as follows:

- The system had to be objective.
- The system had to consider all inmates equally.
- The system needed to allow for the input of additional information related to dangerousness that could not be objectively measured.
- The system had to be capable of being computerized.
- The system had to have the capacity to generate a list of prioritized inmates at any time that releases were necessary.
- The system had to assist in identifying physically dangerous inmates and limiting their potential for release.

The Matrix Process

All criminal charges and holds have been ranked by seriousness and given a point score. For example, Robbery I has a score of 135 points, while Theft I has a score of 14.



These scores are tabled in our computerized booking and population management system. A sub-program including all the matrix elements was written and interfaced with the larger computer system.

As an inmate is booked into custody, the computer identifies the charge with the highest score and then adds points for any additional charges. For example, two points would be added for each additional non-violent felony charge. Points are also added if the charges involve a warrant for failure to appear and/or a probation violation.

In classifying the inmate, our staff enters into the computer system the type of housing required as well as any behavior alerts. Points are added to the inmate's matrix score if he or she is assigned to a restrictive housing unit. Negative behavior categories, such as "assaultive," "escape risk," "unstable," "gang member," "psychological problems," and so forth, are noted to help staff supervising or transporting the inmate to maintain safety and security.

An inmate assigned to close custody with a disruptive behavior alert would receive an additional twenty points, or ten points for each item. Additional points would be added if the inmate had failed on a release program and been returned to custody.

At any time during the inmate's stay that problem behavior is noted and documented by custody staff, classification staff enter additional behavior alerts, and points are then added to the inmate's matrix score. Thus, the inmate's score can change constantly due to new charges or because of the inmate's negative behavior in custody. Each time a change is made on the inmate's record, the computer re-calculates his or her score.

In addition, we frequently receive information from victims, family, or probation officers that an inmate may be dangerous if released in the community. Staff assigned to the matrix process attempt to verify this information. If it is verified, staff enter the information in the computer, and the inmate is excluded from potential early release irrespective of his matrix score.

Finally, inmates charged with violating facility rules are placed on a "Pending Discipline Hearing" status, which adds fifty points to the matrix score. This puts the inmate's score above the level considered for release, and the points remain throughout the duration of any disciplinary sanction. The fact that an inmate written up for a rule violation cannot be released through the matrix system gives staff

additional control in inmate management.

Release Procedures

The Population Release Office is staffed by technicians who enter into the computer items that are not basic elements of the booking process:

information on dangerousness, disciplinary status, and selected behavior alerts. The staff monitors the inmate population and makes projections on the need to initiate releases.

When the population approaches capacity, staff request a computer-generated list of potential releases. This list consists of inmates whose scores range from the lowest possible of fourteen points to a high judged sufficient to provide the necessary releases, generally about seventy points. Staff then review the charges and holds of the inmates slated for release. The office prepares forms to instruct released inmates on reporting for supervision while on release and provide information related to their next court date.

The federal court order enables the sheriff to release pretrial or sentenced inmates on pass or

furlough through this matrix release process, and allows him to place conditions on the pass. To enforce these conditions, the sheriff developed two community supervision programs, which complement the matrix process:

- Sentenced inmates are released from custody on renewable two-week passes. The passes can be renewed until the sentence is completed, as long as the inmate fulfills the conditions of release. These conditions always include reporting and may include treatment. Intensive Supervision Program staff monitor compliance, counsel inmates, and initiate the discipline process if an inmate violates conditions of the pass. The inmate is returned to custody if the violation warrants a change in status. Inmates absconding from supervision are considered to have escaped from custody while on pass.

A matrix process could be implemented in other jurisdictions if local courts could agree to delegate the necessary authority.

- Pretrial defendants are supervised through our Pretrial Monitoring Program. Staff maintain contact with defendants and encourage them to appear in court as ordered by the conditions of release. If the defendant fails to appear in court, a warrant is issued.

If staff in either program learn that a releasee is physically dangerous to the community, action is taken to return the offender to custody.

Summary

The release matrix system has fulfilled our original goal and objectives. We are comfortable that we are doing everything within our power to release the least dangerous inmates to the community. The benefit of the federal court order and the resulting matrix process is that our jail system is not overcrowded. The capacity limits allow us to maintain constitutional standards within our jail system.

The matrix process I have defined could be implemented without the oversight of the federal court, if local courts could agree to delegate the necessary authority. Ideally, a jurisdiction with overcrowding problems could bring together all the

major actors in the local justice system to agree on the elements of a matrix process. The local court could then delegate authority to

the sheriff. Unfortunately, such agreements are often difficult to obtain.

Since the start of our matrix release activity in 1986, we have released more than 10,000 inmates because of

overcrowding. The public has become more aware of the crisis within the criminal justice system and, as a result, was willing to provide funding for additional jail beds.

We now have five county facilities with a system capacity of 1,078 beds. Although this is a 47 percent increase since 1986, we still are releasing approximately 300 persons per month through the matrix system. However, the new jail beds have enabled us to reduce both the number of releases and the average matrix scores of those being released. A county levy for funding additional jail capacity is currently before the voters. We hope that this additional capacity will enable us to discontinue releases due to population pressure.

The only real answer to jail overcrowding is a combination of adequate custody space, sufficient alternatives to incarceration, and a well-managed justice system. Our matrix system allows us to maintain our population limits while the justice system, county and state legislators, and the citizens move to make the real changes that are needed.

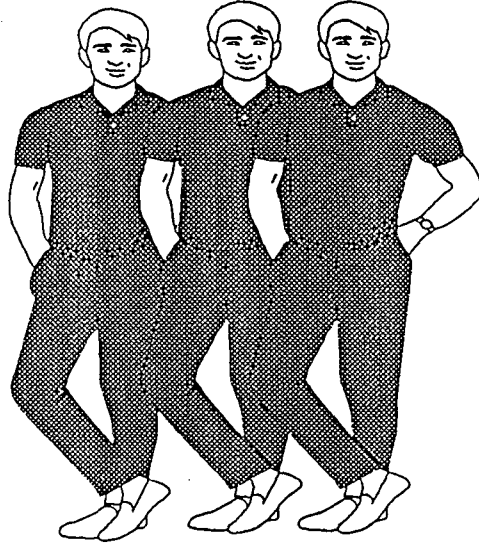

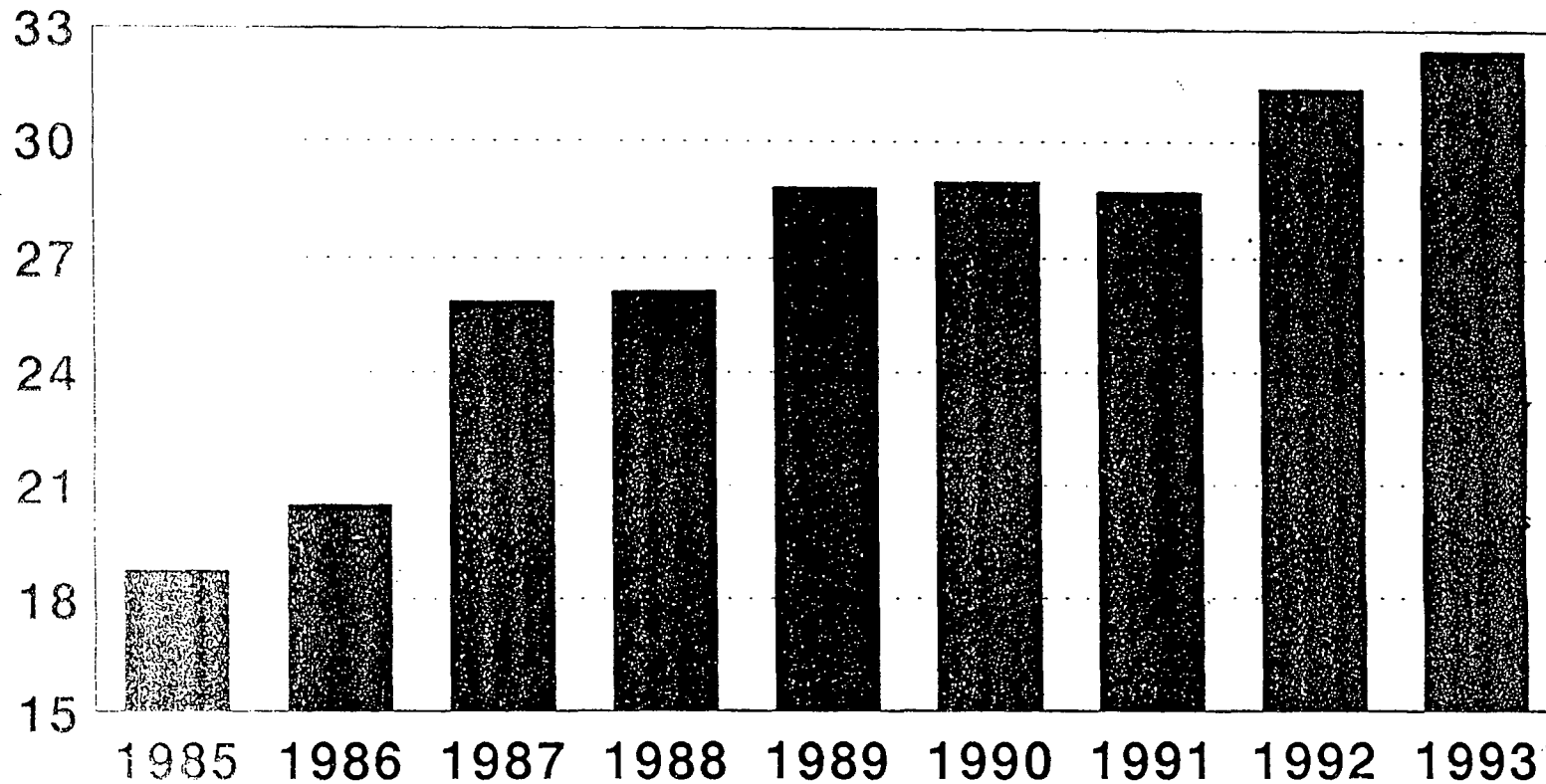

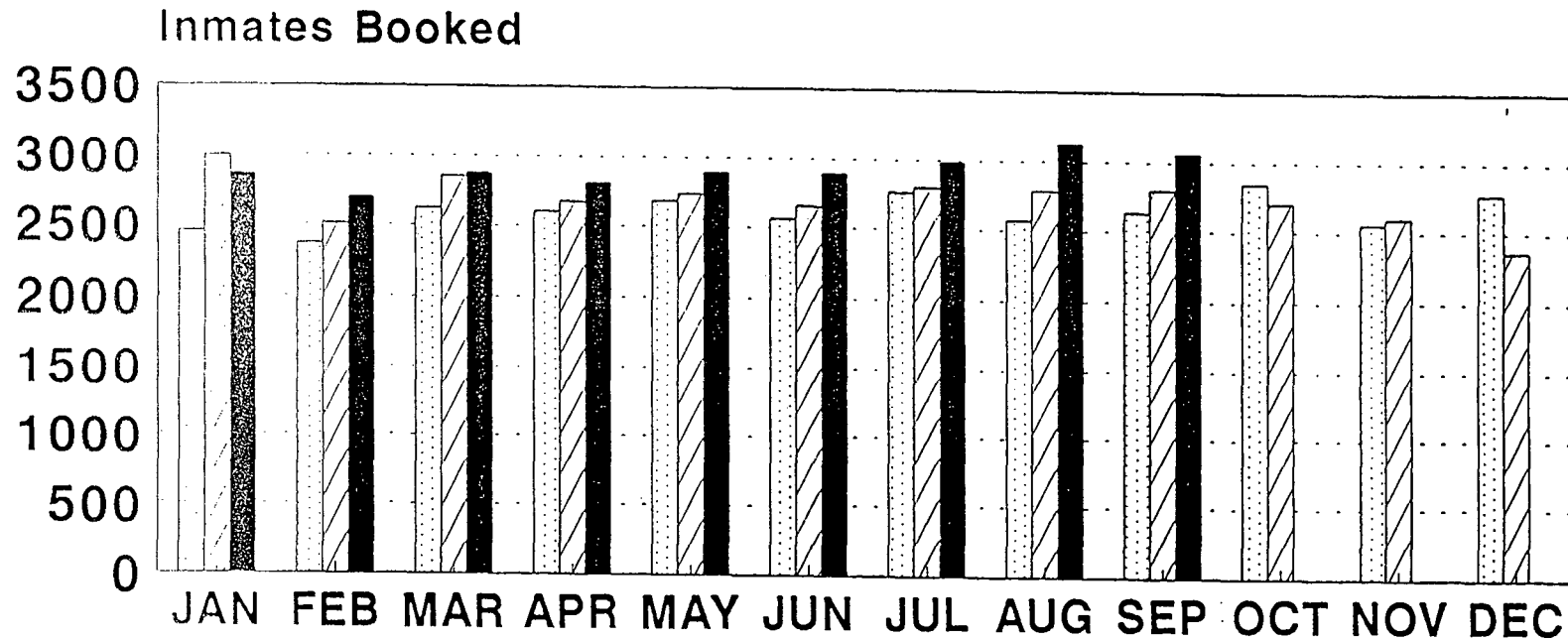

Monthly Totals 1992-1994



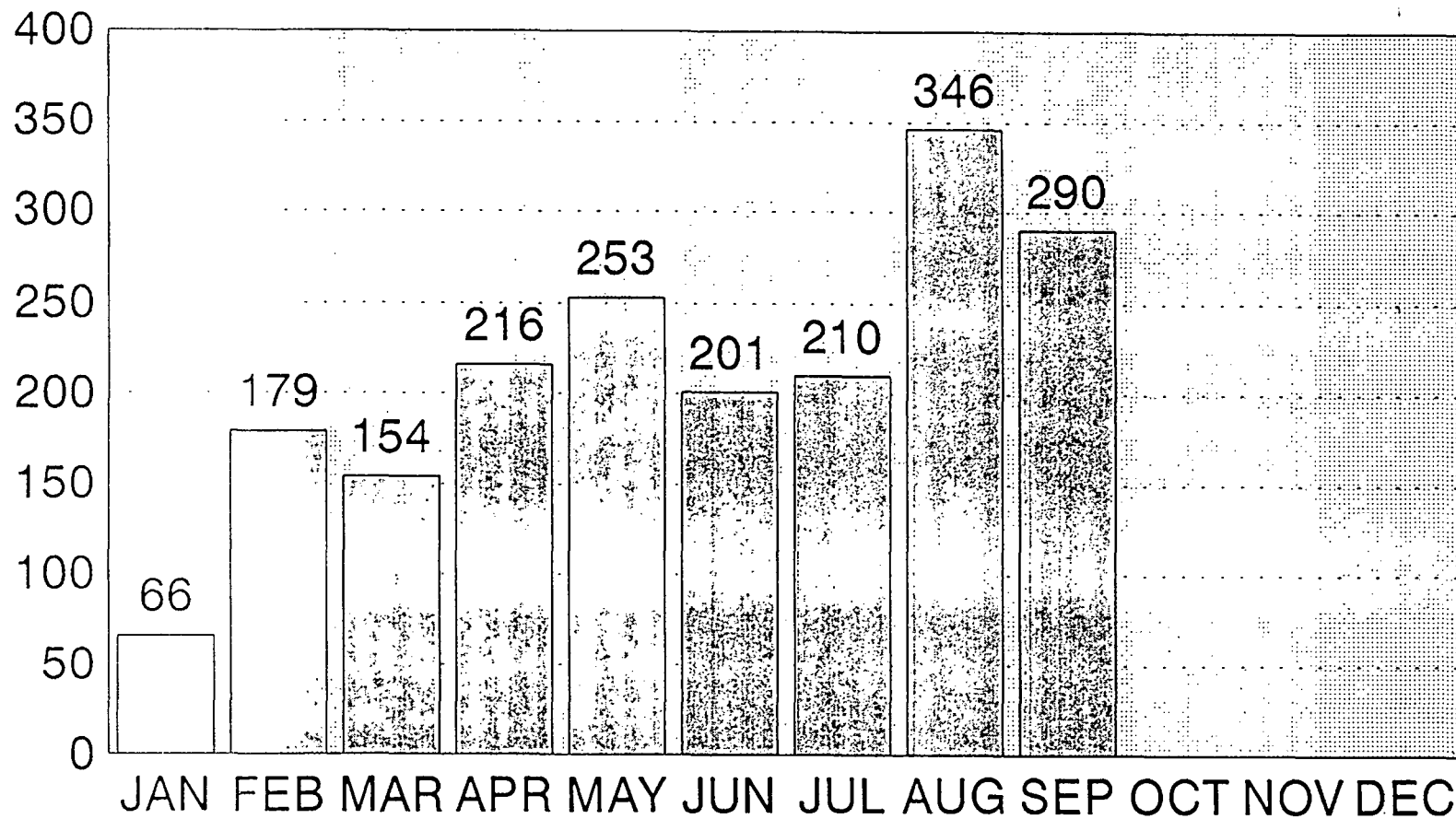

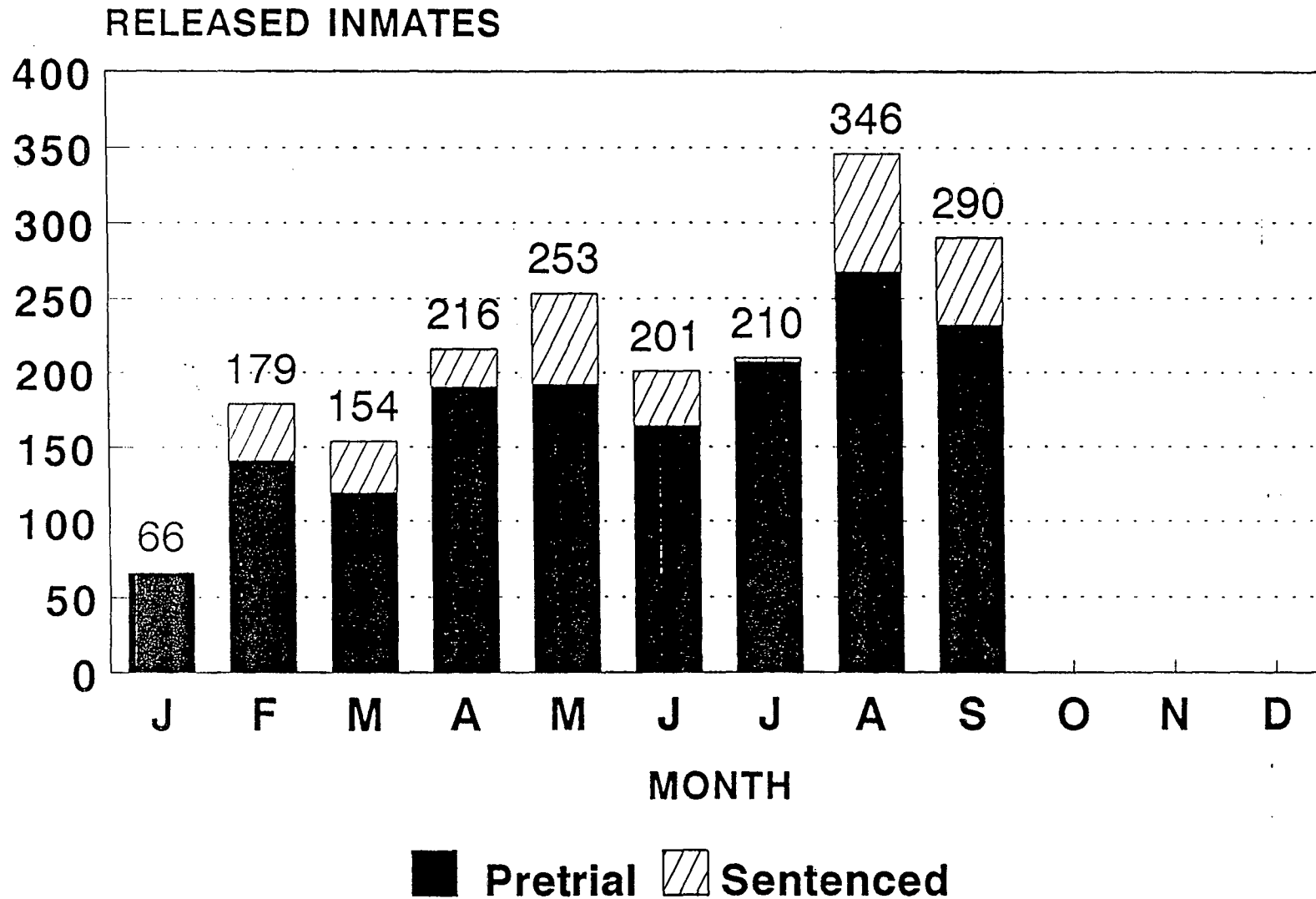

POPULATION RELEASE SCORING

Following is a summary of the variables that are considered and how they are weighted to determine an inmate's population release score.

Primary Charge

The most serious charge is given a score from 9 to 300.

Companion Charges

Additional points are added to the primary charge score for each additional charge.

Exceptional Danger

Inmates who are thought to be a physical danger to persons in the community can be excluded from release. Reasons for exclusion must be specific, and are reviewed daily. An example is domestic violence cases.

The Multnomah County Population Release Matrix System

In 1986, Multnomah County, Oregon, had 732 jail beds and nearly 1,000 inmates. State voters had turned down four prison bond measures since 1980, and county voters had twice rejected local jail and inmate rehabilitation levies. Like many jurisdictions, we had tried numerous population control measures with little long-term success.

The matrix system's goal is to maintain the custody population within the limits established by the court without increasing danger to the community.

To complicate matters, the federal court was looking over our shoulders because of a court order which addressed a jail that had been replaced in 1983 but continued to influence the "new generation" jail in downtown Portland.

From July 1986 through July 1987, we experimented with a release matrix system that depended on the approval and authority of the state

court judges. It became increasingly difficult to use this process, however, because of limitations placed by the local courts.

As a result of our continuing population problems, we returned to the federal court on an extension of the original order. On June 23, 1987, the federal court placed a population cap on two of our three facilities. Discussions with all parties to this action made it clear that without the authority of the federal court, the sheriff would have an extremely difficult time maintaining any capacity limit ordered by the court.

The matrix release program that we had been developing since 1986 was reviewed by the court

and ultimately included in the final court order. This gives the sheriff the authority to release inmates when the population reaches 90 percent of capacity.

Matrix System: Goals and Objectives

The goal of the matrix system is to maintain the custody population

within the limits established by the federal court without increasing danger to the community.

With this goal in mind, we identified a number of objectives to consider in developing the process. These objectives were as follows:

- The system had to be objective.
- The system had to consider all inmates equally.
- The system needed to allow for the input of additional information related to dangerousness that could not be objectively measured.
- The system had to be capable of being computerized.
- The system had to have the capacity to generate a list of prioritized inmates at any time that releases were necessary.
- The system had to assist in identifying physically dangerous inmates and limiting their potential for release.

The Matrix Process

All criminal charges and holds have been ranked by seriousness and given a point score. For example, Robbery I has a score of 135 points, while Theft I has a score of 14.



These scores are tabled in our computerized booking and population management system. A sub-program including all the matrix elements was written and interfaced with the larger computer system.

As an inmate is booked into custody, the computer identifies the charge with the highest score and then adds points for any additional charges. For example, two points would be added for each additional non-violent felony charge. Points are also added if the charges involve a warrant for failure to appear and/or a probation violation.

In classifying the inmate, our staff enters into the computer system the type of housing required as well as any behavior alerts. Points are added to the inmate's matrix score if he or she is assigned to a restrictive housing unit. Negative behavior categories, such as "assaultive," "escape risk," "unstable," "gang member," "psychological problems," and so forth, are noted to help staff supervising or transporting the inmate to maintain safety and security.

An inmate assigned to close custody with a disruptive behavior alert would receive an additional twenty points, or ten points for each item. Additional points would be added if the inmate had failed on a release program and been returned to custody.

At any time during the inmate's stay that problem behavior is noted and documented by custody staff, classification staff enter additional behavior alerts, and points are then added to the inmate's matrix score. Thus, the inmate's score can change constantly due to new charges or because of the inmate's negative behavior in custody. Each time a change is made on the inmate's record, the computer re-calculates his or her score.

In addition, we frequently receive information from victims, family, or probation officers that an inmate may be dangerous if released in the community. Staff assigned to the matrix process attempt to verify this information. If it is verified, staff enter the information in the computer, and the inmate is excluded from potential early release irrespective of his matrix score.

Finally, inmates charged with violating facility rules are placed on a "Pending Discipline Hearing" status, which adds fifty points to the matrix score. This puts the inmate's score above the level considered for release, and the points remain throughout the duration of any disciplinary sanction. The fact that an inmate written up for a rule violation cannot be released through the matrix system gives staff

additional control in inmate management.

Release Procedures

The Population Release Office is staffed by technicians who enter into the computer items that are not basic elements of the booking process:

information on dangerousness, disciplinary status, and selected behavior alerts. The staff monitors the inmate population and makes projections on the need to initiate releases.

When the population approaches capacity, staff request a computer-generated list of potential releases. This list consists of inmates whose scores range from the lowest possible of fourteen points to a high judged sufficient to provide the necessary releases, generally about seventy points. Staff then review the charges and holds of the inmates slated for release. The office prepares forms to instruct released inmates on reporting for supervision while on release and provide information related to their next court date.

The federal court order enables the sheriff to release pretrial or sentenced inmates on pass or

furlough through this matrix release process, and allows him to place conditions on the pass. To enforce these conditions, the sheriff developed two community supervision programs, which complement the matrix process:

- Sentenced inmates are released from custody on renewable two-week passes. The passes can be renewed until the sentence is completed, as long as the inmate fulfills the conditions of release. These conditions always include reporting and may include treatment. Intensive Supervision Program staff monitor compliance, counsel inmates, and initiate the discipline process if an inmate violates conditions of the pass. The inmate is returned to custody if the violation warrants a change in status. Inmates absconding from supervision are considered to have escaped from custody while on pass.

A matrix process could be implemented in other jurisdictions if local courts could agree to delegate the necessary authority.

- Pretrial defendants are supervised through our Pretrial Monitoring Program. Staff maintain contact with defendants and encourage them to appear in court as ordered by the conditions of release. If the defendant fails to appear in court, a warrant is issued.

If staff in either program learn that a releasee is physically dangerous to the community, action is taken to return the offender to custody.

Summary

The release matrix system has fulfilled our original goal and objectives. We are comfortable that we are doing everything within our power to release the least dangerous inmates to the community. The benefit of the federal court order and the resulting matrix process is that our jail system is not overcrowded. The capacity limits allow us to maintain constitutional standards within our jail system.

The matrix process I have defined could be implemented without the oversight of the federal court, if local courts could agree to delegate the necessary authority. Ideally, a jurisdiction with overcrowding problems could bring together all the major actors in the local justice system to agree on the elements of a matrix process. The local court could then delegate authority to

the sheriff. Unfortunately, such agreements are often difficult to obtain.

Since the start of our matrix release activity in 1986, we have released more than 10,000 inmates because of

overcrowding. The public has become more aware of the crisis within the criminal justice system and, as a result, was willing to provide funding for additional jail beds.

We now have five county facilities with a system capacity of 1,078 beds. Although this is a 47 percent increase since 1986, we still are releasing approximately 300 persons per month through the matrix system. However, the new jail beds have enabled us to reduce both the number of releases and the average matrix scores of those being released. A county levy for funding additional jail capacity is currently before the voters. We hope that this additional capacity will enable us to discontinue releases due to population pressure.

The only real answer to jail overcrowding is a combination of adequate custody space, sufficient alternatives to incarceration, and a well-managed justice system. Our matrix system allows us to maintain our population limits while the justice system, county and state legislators, and the citizens move to make the real changes that are needed.

Primary Charge

The most serious charge is given a score from 9 to 300.

Companion Charges

Additional points are added to the primary charge score for each additional charge.

Exceptional Danger

Inmates who are thought to be a physical danger to persons in the community can be excluded from release. Reasons for exclusion must be specific, and are reviewed daily. An example is domestic violence cases.

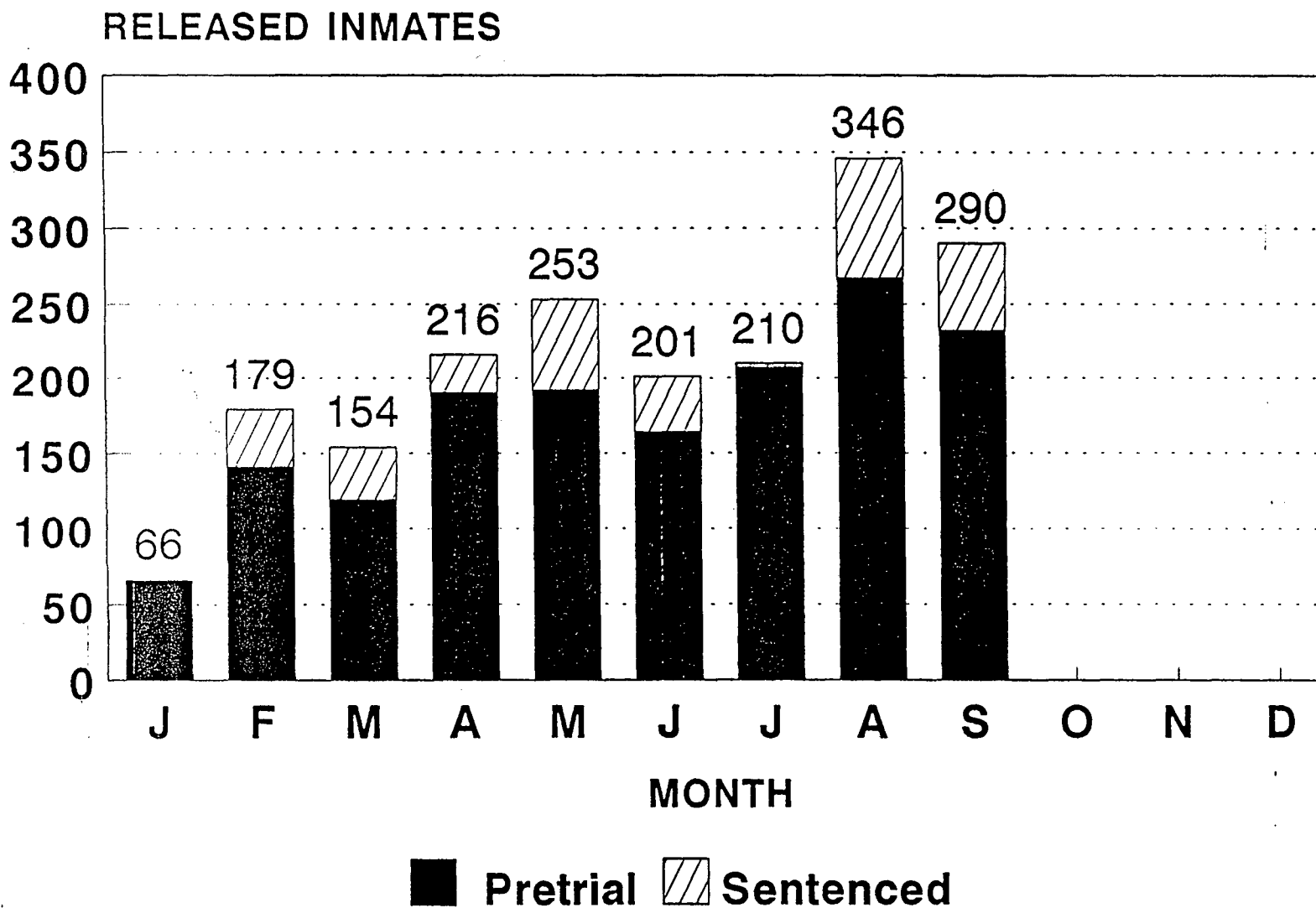

SUPPLEMENTAL QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM BEVERLY STEIN, COUNTY CHAIR
ON NOVEMBER 7, 1994 FOR THE NOVEMBER 10, 1994 BOARD BRIEFING

1. How does the consent decree signed with the federal court structure our release system?

The procedures for the operation of the matrix system were submitted to and approved by the federal court.

Under the consent decree, what parties have what authority for release decisions?

The Sheriff has the authority to make releases consistent with the approved procedures.

2. How was the current system designed?

The system used in Lane County was reviewed and used as part of our system. The County Counsel's Office, Sheriff's Office, inmates attorneys and the Federal Court Judge reviewed and considered the system.

How does it weigh competing priorities of appearance at court, danger to the community, completion of sentences imposed by the court, discipline within jail.

Danger to the community is the primary concern in the process. Discipline in the facility is related to danger in the community - ie. assaultive in jail would pose a concern in the community. FTA history adds points but does not significantly effect the score.

After considerable input from Judges and others a change was submitted to federal court that allowed us to give priority to pretrial defendant (persons not convicted of the offense) and then to release sentenced when the score on pretrial reaches 65.

How does the weighing of these priorities compare with those used by PRSP and Close Street?

Close Street gives priority attention to A & B felony clients which are not generally reached in the matrix process.

Recog considers the criteria in the statutes. Generally issues considered relate to stability and FTA with also some consideration to danger.

PRSP supervises the recog release that are considered higher risk FTA and ones that have the higher risk of danger.

Who has authority to make changes in the current system?

Any substantial change in the Matrix System would need to be recommended by the Sheriff's Office to the Federal Court. This would be expensive because the plaintiff's attorney would generally be brought into the picture. Expenses of such an action would generally be the counties.

The court has the authority to make changes in the recog release process consistent with related ORS.

3. How is the current system staffed?

Five corrections technicians under the supervision of the Classification Unit Supervisor.

What is the role of the matrix staff in making release decisions and preparing people to leave jail?

They enter a considerable amount of data into the computer system that effects the individual scores. They review and enter danger information that is called in by all parts of the system. They contact known victims to determine danger and concern. They review potential releases and refer individuals of concern to the supervisor. They talk to inmates pending release to verify addresses if the computer fails to note a resident address. After releases are identified the staff determine court dates and prepare release orders. Staff notify transfer so the inmates can be prepared and transported for release. This is in addition to other duties assigned to the staff.

4. Do we have data on length of stay in jail awaiting trial?

We have length of stay data at release by charge category and release reasons.

Does it vary significantly by type of charge?

We only have it by charge level - A,B or C felony etc. It does vary, as we would expect, with the more serious charges staying longer.

Are there efforts to reduce the time for offenders awaiting trial?

Yes, the court is generally very efficient in managing its courts. On a national basis, I have been told that our court has a very short arrest to trial time. These issues, concerns, and any changes are issues of discussion at the Presiding Judges regular monthly meeting. (ie. - Drug Diversion)

Is there an issue with Hispanics awaiting deportation being held beyond normal release dates?

When local charges are disposed of illegal immigrants are quickly removed from custody. Very few custody days are used by persons awaiting deportation. The average for last month was less than two beds/day (1.4 beds/day average).

Various states are working on ways to reduce the time that illegal immigrants stay in jails, including getting the ability to deport prior to trial. Are we pursuing such options?

This is an issue for the court and the DA's office. While we could take part in such discussions it is outside our authority and position.

The recently signed Crime Bill has a section related to sentenced illegal immigrants. We have asked the County Counsels Office to check into this issue and of any potentials of us transferring responsibility of sentenced illegal immigrants to federal authorities.

5. We are in a situation of releasing offenders through the matrix system when we have capacity at MCRC and Close Street. What changes in criteria would we need to make to ensure that these programs are at capacity prior to releasing individuals under the matrix system?

Both the Close Street Program and the Restitution Center's population fluctuate. CSS is a pretrial release supervision program while the Restitution Center is for screened sentenced offenders. We are concerned about this situation and are considering a number of options with the goal of maximizing both programs prior to matrixing or at the time of matrixing.

Restitution Center

- We recently worked out short form screening process for certain type of offenders which was approved by the Citizen Advisory Committee. This will speed acceptance of lower risk offenders.

- We have recently met with the Chief Criminal Judge to encourage the use of the Restitution Center. We will be sending a letter to each judge and will be inviting them to the Center.
- We are working with community corrections to try to get PO's to utilize the center for administrative sanctions. So far our effort to get the Probation Officers to use the Restitution Center has not been successful. Tamara Holden is working with us to try to encourage PO's to use the Center. As the administrative process is used more by PO's, we expect that the Restitution center will be a very valuable intermediate sanction for the system.

Close Street

- We are considering referring selected matrix releases to CSS for supervision when they have available capacity.
- It is important that we not reduce the quality program at CSS or their priority to consider A + B cases who can be supervised in the community.
