REAPPOINTING MEMBERS AND APPOINTING NEW MEMBERS TO THE MULTNOMAH COUNTY BUSINESS ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Private sector business activity and employment are the vital backbone of our community.
- b. Regional prosperity has been severely impacted by the recent recession as high levels of unemployment persist in the Portland Metropolitan Statistical Area, severely impacting individuals and families in Multnomah County.
- c. Job growth and business expansion are pressing needs in our community.
- d. The individuals who live and work within Multnomah County possess a wealth of knowledge about business issues from which the County can benefit.
- e. Pursuant to Ordinance 1183, Multnomah County created the Business Advisory Council to help improve the local business climate by establishing a forum for improving communication between the business community and county government while working to help make Multnomah County an even better place to do business.
- f. Harnessing the talent and energy of our local business community through the Business Advisory Council continues to be an important strategy to boost the success of the regional economy.
- g. Members of the Business Advisory Council are appointed for terms of up to two years, with terms staggered so that no more than half of the terms are set to expire in a given year.
- h. Pursuant to Ordinance 1183 and the County Charter, the Chair is to appoint individuals to the Business Advisory Council who live or work within Multnomah County and who possess expertise in areas of economic development, entrepreneurship, and social equity, and the full Board of County Commissioners approves advisory committee appointments made by the Chair.
- i. The Chair appoints the following individuals to the Business Advisory Council as new members or reappointed members, as indicated, each for a term ending on June 30, 2015:

David Golobay (new member)
Nick Hodson (new member)
Roy Jay (new member)
Pat Mobley (new member)
Carlos Moreno (new member)

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. The Board of County Commissioners approves of the appointment of the following individuals to the Business Advisory Council for terms commencing as of the passage of this resolution: Terry Brandt, David Golobay, Nick Hodson, Roy Jay, Pat Mobley, and Carlos Moreno, each for a term ending on June 30, 2015.
