ORDINANCE NO. 291

An Ordinance relating to use of County vehicles by elected officials.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The elected County officials and the District Attorney of Multnomah County may elect to have permanent full-time use of a County-owned vehicle.

Section 2. If a County official or the District Attorney so elects, he/she shall consent to payroll deduction of \$30 per month to be credited to the General Fund in payment for such vehicle use.

Section 3. If a County official or the District Attorney elects not to have a permanently assigned County vehicle, that official may apply for reimbursement for transportation expenses incurred on official County business, in accordance with Internal Revenue Service regulations relating to such reimbursement.
