The position will also develop and maintain effective working relationships with team members and assigned communities and participate in regular team, group and individual case conferences. The purpose of Community Health Specialist 2 is to develop and conduct activities designed to protect and improve community health; to provide health information, advocacy, social support and assistance in using the healthcare system to groups and to families. Qualifications for this position are equivalent to a high school diploma and two years of experience providing community outreach or health services and programs to diverse populations. The purpose, responsibilities and qualifications of this position are consistent with Community Health Specialist 2 (6047).
