

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON

ORDINANCE NO. 142

An Ordinance increasing the minimum pension of employees retiring after July 1, 1949; amending Section 9 and Section 10 of Multnomah County Ordinance No. 78; and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 9.D. of Multnomah County Ordinance No. 78 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"D. Any person retiring after January 1, 1966, who is eligible for payment under subsection A of this section shall be paid at least \$65 per month, plus \$3.50 per month for each year of continuous service in excess of 15 years, or \$200 per month, whichever is more, excepting those who have elected early retirement or have exercised joint annuity options under this section."

Section 2. Section 10.B. of Multnomah County Ordinance No. 78 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"B. Employees retiring after July 1, 1949, whether by reaching the compulsory age of retirement or because of disability

shall receive at least \$200 per month, excepting those who have elected early retirement or have exercised joint annuity options."

Section 3. Benefits payable under a joint annuity option under Section 9.G. of Ordinance 78 shall be appropriately adjusted to conform to the minimum benefits payable by reason of this Ordinance.


Section 4. The benefits provided by this amending Ordinance shall apply retroactively to March 1, 1977.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by providing increased benefits for certain retired employees, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.


