Authorizing the Acquisition of Real Property for a Public Improvement Project on S. E. Cochran Road, in East Multnomah County.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. It is necessary for Multnomah County to acquire the real property interests described in attached Exhibit A (the "Property") for purposes of constructing, operating, maintaining, repairing, replacing, and reconstructing road facilities which includes bridge structures, culverts, approaches, access ways, slopes, and drainage ways on a portion of SE Cochran Road (a.k.a Cochrane Road), situated partially in unincorporated Multnomah County, and partially in the City of Troutdale (the "Project").
- b. The Project has been planned and located in a manner that is most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. It is necessary to acquire the Property described in Exhibit A for purposes of the Project.
2. Multnomah County Transportation Division (Division) is directed to begin negotiations to acquire the Property in accordance with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations governing such acquisition. Legal counsel is directed to assist the Division as necessary in such negotiations. Any agreement to purchase Property described in Exhibit A is subject to Board approval.
