Proclaiming Election Results Relating to Annexation of Territory to the Columbia River People's Utility District.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Whereas at an election duly and regularly held on the 16th day of May, 2017, within Multnomah and Columbia Counties , State of Oregon, and within the boundaries of a proposed annexation of the Columbia River People's Utility District, there was submitted to the electors thereof the question whether or not territory presently within the allocated service territory of Columbia River People's Utility District be annexed into the Columbia River People's Utility District political boundaries: Question 26-191 in Multnomah County, and Question 26-192 in Columbia County; and
- b. Whereas at the election so held in Multnomah County a total of a total of 57 ballots were received on 26-191 and 55 votes were cast in favor of annexation of the Multnomah County territory, and 2 votes were cast against annexation. In Columbia County a total of 68 - 68 votes were received, and 66 votes were cast in favor of annexation of the Columbia County territory, and 2 votes were cast against annexation;
- c. Whereas the annexation of the Multnomah County territory received the affirmative vote of the majority of the votes cast at the election; and the annexation of the Columbia County territory received the affirmative vote of the majority of the votes cast in the election;
- d. Now, therefore, the undersigned hereby does proclaim and declare that all of that part of the State of Oregon, described in Exhibit A and Exhibit B attached to this Proclamation, and by this reference made a part hereof, has been duly and legally annexed into the Columbia River People's Utility District under and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Oregon.
