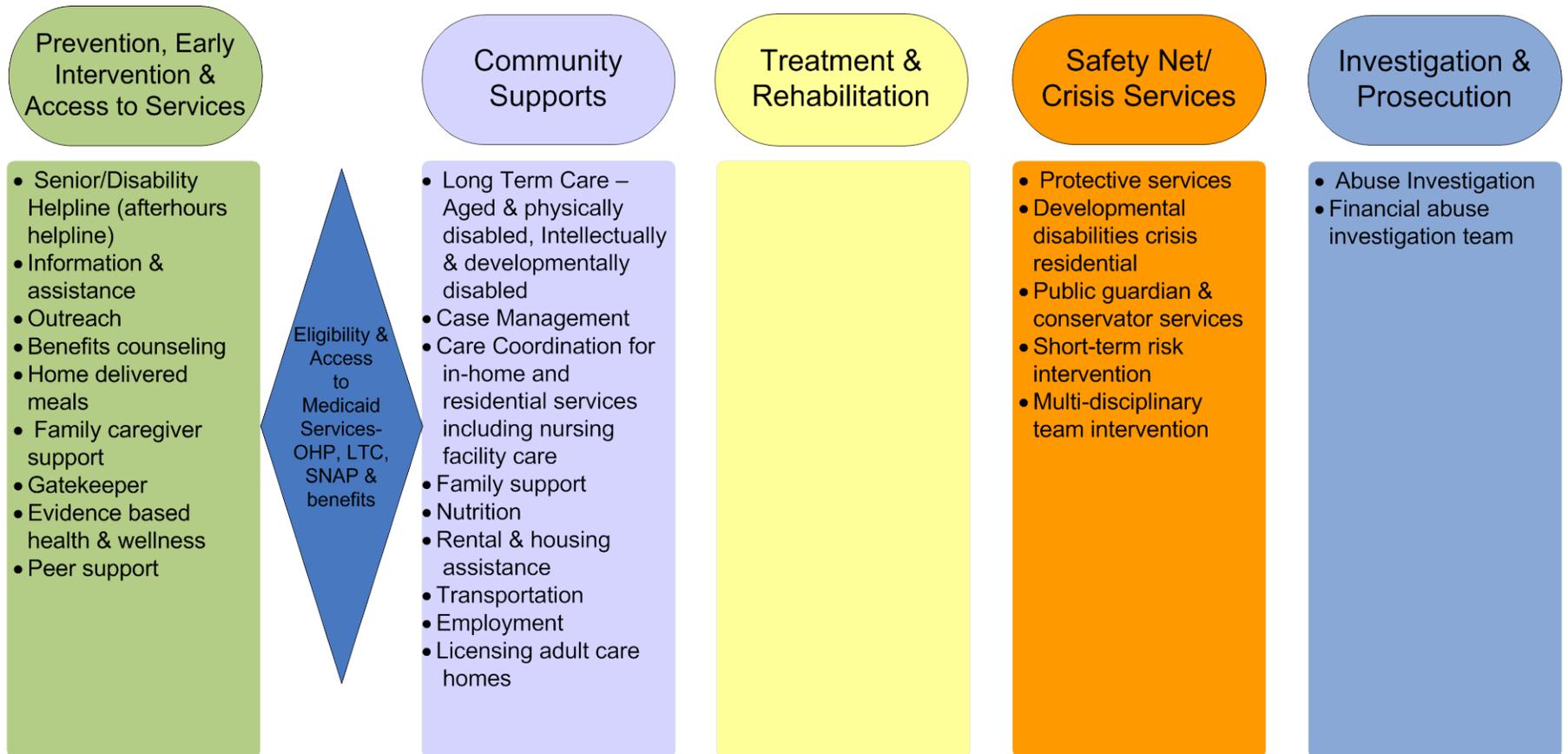

The unit conducts monthly review of each service element to ensure they balance to the State CPMS system for those services paid by the county and to eXPRS for those services paid directly by the state. The unit is responsible for submitting all required forms to the State for client service changes, monitoring funding for services and ensuring appropriate application of waived services. Of these, approximately 880 children aged birth through age 17 are actively enrolled in the Family Support Program. Family support services include referrals to community resources, family-to-family support groups, and training opportunities. It also provides funding for respite care, adaptive equipment, and medical supplies. Abuse investigators screen over 4,000 serious event reports per year and conduct an average of 260 investigations annually. These services range from short-term crisis support or crisis placement, to in-home supports and/or long-term residential placements. The unit is responsible for arranging placements and managing facility support services, and monitoring services provided by contracted agencies and/or families.
