Can you help review this IGA?

I received this draft IGA from Metro on Jan 3. It is essentially an agreement that says we'll capitalize the assets funded by a Metro grant. We partnered with the Johnson Creek Watershed Council to have them manage a fish passage retrofit on one of our culverts. They have been awarded the grant, and we are the government sponsor as the culvert owner.

They are asking for a quick turn around: Jan 13. Is this possible?

These are also template IGAs that we ask local government sponsors of grant projects to sign that pretty much state that your agency will capitalize the asset being constructed by JCWC and will maintain that asset until at least 2027. The grant agreement and grant application will be an Exhibit to that IGA. Please review these and let me know if you have any concerns about the language. The City of Portland has signed similar agreements but I think it's a first for Mult Co. It would be great to hear back from you by January 13th.
