RESOLUTION NO. 2019-004

Confirming Interim Designation for Multnomah County Sheriff.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Multnomah County Charter Section 4.50(3) and Multnomah County Code 5.003 require that elected officials designate an interim occupant to serve until a vacancy is filled by election or appointment.
- b. Charter Section 4.10 states the qualifications for County officers and Code Section 5.003(B)(4) requires that the designee meet the Charter qualifications for appointees of such offices.
- c. Michael Reese, Multnomah County Sheriff, designates Nicole Morrisey O'Donnell as interim occupant of that office in the event of a vacancy.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

The Board confirms Nicole Morrisey O'Donnell to serve as interim occupant for the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office in the event of a vacancy in that office.
