General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of the purchase of property interests necessary for the construction of road improvements associated with Transportation's NE Arata Road Project.

On Dec. 11, 2014 and March 10, 2016 the Board of County Commissioners approved Resolutions No. 2014-140 and No. 2016-016, respectively, directing the Department of Community Services Transportation Division (Transportation) to begin negotiations to acquire certain real property interests necessary for a road improvement and street widening project along NE Arata Road in the Cities of Wood Village and Fairview.

Transportation conducted negotiations as authorized under Resolutions No. 2014-140, and 2016-016, with abutting property owners for acquisition of certain Easements necessary to construct road improvements along NE Arata Road. Copies of the Easements which contain the negotiated settlement are included in Exhibit 1 to this Resolution. The negotiated considerations for these Easements were based on appraisals produced by licensed Professional Appraisers, and have been reviewed by an independent Professional Appraisal Reviewer.

Sufficient funds have been secured by Transportation to proceed with final design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction of the improvements.
