## General Information

### 1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

The County Land Use and Transportation Program (LUTP) is requesting the Board approve the vacation of a portion of the NE 242<sup>nd</sup> Connector, a County Road as more particularly described in the Exhibit A to the Resolution.

### 2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

The NE 242<sup>nd</sup> Connector, County Road No. 5007, is an unimproved, but dedicated public right of way area.

The first appearance before the Board in this proposed vacation of a portion of the NE 242<sup>nd</sup> Connector was on January 29, 2015. At that time the Board set March 12, 2015 as the time to receive the written report of the County Engineer as required under ORS 368.346 (1).

At the March 12<sup>th</sup> appearance before the Board, there was an acknowledgement of the receipt of the report of the County Engineer. The report explained in more detail the history of the NE 242<sup>nd</sup> Connector and why there is no further need to maintain it as public right of way. On March 12, 2015 the Board established the time and place for the public

hearing to consider the proposed vacation to be June 25, 2015, as required under ORS 368.346(2).

This June 25th hearing is the final action in this County initiated road vacation proceeding under ORS 368.326 - ORS 368.366. Notice of this hearing has been provided in compliance with ORS 368.401 - ORS 368.426.

**3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).**

This is a County initiated action. Multnomah County is responsible for all costs associated with this proceeding.

**4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.**

**5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.**

Notice has been provided to those parties entitled to notice under ORS Chapter 368. The portion of the NE 242<sup>nd</sup> Connector identified for vacation is situated entirely within the City of Troutdale. For the vacation proceedings to be effective, the City of Troutdale must, by Order or Resolution, concur with the findings of the County, pursuant to ORS 368.361(3).
