RESOLUTION
91 - 151

WHEREAS The Portland Planning Bureau is currently considering alternative land use plans for the Albina Community which could lead to re-zoning and consequent elimination of the County Expo Center; and

WHEREAS The County Expo Center is the largest trade show facility in the region, and provides an unduplicated showcase for thousands of businesses in the region; and is of vast economic importance to local businesses; and

WHEREAS The County Expo Center has site access, proximity, and size that is irreplaceable within the urban core of the region; and

WHEREAS The County Expo Center is a profit generator of major significance to County government; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners formally states its opposition to any change of zoning for the Expo Center site that will inhibit, limit, or eliminate the continued operation, and improvement of the Center as an exhibition and trade show facility; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Chair shall transmit this Resolution to the Portland Planning Bureau, Portland Planning Commission, and Portland City Council, and take appropriate legal steps, as required to protect the viability of the County Expo Center.
