Jon and Megan,

Please find enclosed a marked up copy of the APR. I couldn't mark up my changes in the IGA because I only had it in PDF format. In the future, please send all draft contracts and IGAs in Word - this makes it faster for you to finalize once I've sent it back with any revisions.

Here are my comments on the IGA:

- Exhibit B, Section 1: delete "proposed project" and replace with "Project" since Project was defined in paragraph 1 of the IGA Terms.
- Attachment 1, Section 2: This section asks the County to guarantee available funding for the project. Because the funding for this is spread across multiple years, we cannot guarantee that funding will be available because we can not bind future County Boards. Consequently, I suggest adding the following underlined language: "Agency guarantees the availability of Agency funding in an amount required to fully fund Agency's share of the Project, subject to Agency Board approval."

The APR and IGA are approved with these revisions.

Thanks, and my apologies for not getting this back to you sooner.

Thanks for your review.

After your discussion with Ian are you good with the IGA or do you still want the changes that are not related to the funding made?

We usually send the word version of the IGA before we send it to ODOT to our county attorney reviewer. We send any comments then to ODOT and their attorneys review it. When it comes back they just send the pdf because they assume it is done. I send the pdf and apr back to our attorney to verify that ODOT did not make any changes, or at least none that we can't live with.

If we change anything at this point we have to tell ODOT, they have to make the change, and then they have to send it back to DOJ for another cycle.

Sorry for the long email, we can adjust our process to meet whatever you feel is appropriate, just let me know.
