ORDINANCE NO. 113

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 64, as amended, transferring responsibility for certain corrections related activities from the Department of Human Services to the Department of Justice Services; and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 64, as amended, is further amended by deleting subparagraphs 4 and 5 from Section 4.A. and by amending subparagraph 4 of Section 4.C. to read:

"4. Provide housing, counseling and treatment of persons referred or ordered through the judicial process, including probation and parole services; provide minimum security custody and juvenile housing facilities; and provide facilities for detention of maximum and close custody prisoners; and"

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the people of Multnomah County for the immediate implementation of the transfer of responsibilities for correctional activities in an orderly manner, an emergency is declared, and this ordinance shall take effect on its enactment pursuant to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.

ADOPTED this 28th day of November, 1975, being the date of its first reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
