WHEREAS, The Multnomah County Board of County Commissioners formed the Ramsey-Walmar Special Road District by Order on September 19, 1985, in accordance with ORS 371.305 to 371.360 for the purpose of providing regular maintenance of roads within the District not maintained by Multnomah County because such roads do not meet County standards; and

WHEREAS, ORS 371.338 provides the powers of the special road district vested in a board of three commissioners appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the term of Harry Czyzewski, who was appointed pursuant to Board Order 96-82 has expired.

WHEREAS, Patrick McNamara has been nominated to fill the open position and he is otherwise eligible and willing to serve; now therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Patrick McNamara be appointed a commissioner of the Ramsey-Walmar Special Road District to serve a term beginning on September 4, 1997 and ending on December 31, 1999, consistent with ORS 371.338; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to ORS 371.338(3), before entering upon the duties of office, Mr. McNamara shall take and subscribe an oath to support the Constitution and laws of the state of Oregon and of the United States, and to well and faithfully perform the duties of office to be best of the commissioner's knowledge and ability.


