RESOLUTION NO. 00-107

Setting a Public Hearing Date for the Proposed Surrender of Jurisdiction of Certain Portions of County Road No. 565 and Additional Unnamed Right-of-Way to the City of Troutdale

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The City of Troutdale has requested the County to surrender jurisdiction of the following County Roads and additional right-of-way to the City of Troutdale:
 1. N.E. HENSLEY RD (COUNTY RD 565) FROM N.E. 257TH DRIVE TO N.E. 262ND AVE;
 2. N.E. 262ND AVE (COUNTY RD 565) FROM N.E. HENSLEY RD TO N.E. CHERRY PARK RD;
 3. AN UNNAMED RIGHT-OF-WAY DIRECTLY EAST OF THE SOUTHERN N.E. CHERRY PARK RD AND EAST OF N.E. 257TH DR (PUBLIC RD NE CHERRY PARK EXTENSION).
- b. ORS 373.270 grants authority to the County to surrender jurisdiction of county roads within the corporate limits of any city. The roads and right-of-way referenced above are within the City of Troutdale.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. That this matter be set for a public hearing on the 31st day of August, 2000 at 9:30 a.m. before the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners, Multnomah County Courthouse, Boardroom 602, 1021 SW Fourth Avenue, Portland, Oregon.
2. That the County Engineer, or his designated representative, is hereby directed to give notice of the above referenced hearing by posting a Notice of Hearing in the Oregonian and the Gresham Outlook once a week for four consecutive weeks, in accordance with the provisions of ORS 373.270.
