ORDINANCE NO. 483

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 477 relating to the Task Force on Potentially Dangerous and Chronically Mentally Ill Persons:

Multnomah County Ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

Section 2.B. is amended to read:

- B. Developing criteria and recommendations for system improvement and change including;
1. Improvements in planning and coordination between the City Police, the District Attorney, the Circuit and District Courts and County Mental Health Programs regarding Chronically Mentally Ill Persons; and

SECTION 2.

Section 3. is amended to read:

- A. The Task Force shall consist of [seventeen (17)] eighteen (18) members appointed by the County Executive pursuant to the Charter of Multnomah County.

B. The membership shall be composed of the following representatives:
