Outputs

426 youth served

79% students of color

60% identified as being "at risk of academic failure"

79% qualified for free and reduced lunch

42 adults served

73 people served in non-enrollment events

(family educational nights, cultural fairs, etc.)

Outcomes

82% of students increased benchmark scores in Reading

80% of students increased benchmark scores in Math

Average daily attendance of SUN CS students was 94%

According to teachers, of students who regularly attended SUN CS:

49% improved **classroom academic performance**

43% improved getting **homework** in on time

59% **participated** in class more

48% improved **behavior**

45% came to school more **motivated to learn**
